# Studio Art Bachelor of Arts

Effective beginning Academic Year 2019-20 (Last revised October 7, 2019)

The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Art degree with a specialization in Studio Art at Bowling Green State University for students who completed an Associate of Arts degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Studio/Fine Arts Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

It is not guaranteed to count toward a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Studio Art and would be evaluated on a course-by-course basis along with any audition, portfolio, or other requirements that the receiving institution requires of its own students. Students should check with individual institutions for their program admission and degree requirements. Students may need to take additional coursework to meet required competencies.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Students must complete the Bowling Green Perspective (BGP) requirements, which include select courses that meet the International Perspective (satisfied by completion of OAH005) and the Cultural Diversity in the United States requirements at BGSU. These can often be fulfilled as part of the associate degree with careful course selection. Please work with your advisor to identify appropriate courses.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Assumes the student has completed the first two semesters of the foreign language sequence prior to entering BGSU.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The College of Arts and Sciences at BGSU requires a four-course Multidisciplinary Component (MDC). The four courses selected for the MDC may be closely related to the major, sample the diverse domains of the arts, humanities, natural sciences, and social sciences, or be interdisciplinary in nature. Each course must have a different prefix; at least two courses must be at 3000- or 4000-level; and course applied to the MDC will not fulfill other Arts and Sciences degree requirements, not will MDC courses fulfill the major, minor, BGP, or other program requirements.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Assumes the student selects a 21 semester hour minor and completes at least one course in the minor discipline prior to entering BGSU.
