

Effective beginning Academic Year 2023-2024 (Last revised June 29, 2023)

The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Art History degree at Kent State University for students who completed an Associate of Arts degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Art History Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

<p>Advising Notes:            Completion of the Ohio Transfer 36 will satisfy the entire set of Kent Core requirements.  <sup>1</sup> Students must complete the Kent State diversity course requirement, which includes one course with a domestic diversity focus and one course with a global diversity focus (satisfied by ARTH 22020) from the approved list. These can often be fulfilled as part of the associate degree with careful course selection. Please work with your advisor to identify appropriate courses.  <sup>2</sup> Assumes the student has completed the first two semesters of the foreign language sequence prior to entering Kent State. Students must complete one language through the intermediate II level. If students are placed in or test out of the intermediate II level they may take another language or may take general electives to fulfill the remaining requirements. Students seeking information on placement options please visit the Foreign Language Placement policy.  <sup>3</sup> Kent State requires that students successfully complete a minimum of 39 upper-division credit hours. Students may elect an established minor or a block of approved courses chosen in consultation with an advisor in lieu of an established minor. Students not choosing a minor must have all their coursework approved in writing by the School of Art and the College of the Arts.  <sup>4</sup> Kent State requires a total of 120 credits hours for bachelor's degree completion. The total number of hours to complete the bachelor's degree represents a range of hours that may be needed depending on the individual course selections made during the associate degree program.</p>
