¹ Students must complete the Kent State diversity course requirement, which includes one course with a domestic diversity focus and one course with a global diversity focus from the approved list. These can often be fulfilled as part of the associate degree with careful course selection. Please work with your advisor to identify appropriate courses.

² Assumes the student has completed the first two semesters of the foreign language sequence prior to entering Kent State.

³ A maximum of 15 credit hours of lower-division English courses (ENG 10000 or 20000 level) will count toward the major. The College of Arts and Sciences requires that students successfully complete a minimum of 39 upper-division credit hours.

⁴ Kent State requires a total of 120 credits hours for bachelor's degree completion. The total number of hours to complete the bachelor's degree represents a range of hours that may be needed depending on the individual course selections made during the associate degree.
