

Effective beginning Academic Year 2021-22 (Last revised May 23, 2023)

The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Studio Art degree at Ohio University for students who completed an Associate of Arts degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Studio/Fine Arts Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

Advising Notes: <sup>1</sup> Assumes the student has completed the first two semesters of the foreign language sequence prior to entering Ohio University. <sup>2</sup> To qualify for a bachelor's degree, a student must complete all Ohio University graduation requirements: BRICKS general education, college, major, and residency. Students must complete a minimum of 60 semester hours of A&S courses at the 2000-level or above, and must complete at least 33 hours of courses from the list of approved A&S distribution area courses including 9 semester hours each of Humanities, Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences. Courses transferred in as 2000-level or higher A&S courses will count toward the 60 semester hours. Ohio University requires a minimum of 120 credit hours to earn a bachelor's degree. The total number of hours to complete the bachelor's degree may vary depending on the individual course selections made during the associate degree program.
