It is not guaranteed to count toward a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Theatre and would be evaluated on a course-by-course basis along with any audition, portfolio, or other requirements that the receiving institution requires of its own students. Students should check with individual institutions for their program admission and degree requirements.

Some bachelor-degree granting institutions require additional general education courses outside of the Ohio Transfer Module and students may be required to take these courses in their junior or senior year. Students will still be able to follow this pathway and complete their bachelor's degree in approximately 60 additional credit hours.
