## Getting to Know



Ohio's Help Me Grow program this week launches Sparkler, a new platform for families and providers (early care and education, schools, medical) to be able to complete developmental screenings and share the results and resources with each other.

Parents can use their mobile device to:


- Download the *Sparkler: Play for Parenting* app
- Create an account
- Add one or more children
- Complete free ASQs with their child
- Share the screening results with their child's providers
- Access age-appropriate activities to foster growth and development
- Get parenting tips
- Upload pictures to their Sparkler account that can "scrapbook" a child's progress and help parents see that what they're doing day to day is having an impact on their child's development

Providers who are working with families and choose to or are requested to complete developmental screenings to meet compliance standards (such as Step Up to Quality) can become a PROGRAM PARTNER. As a program partner, you can:

- Get access to a Sparkler dashboard specific to your program
- Share an assigned program code with your families and gain access to their child's screening results
- Print screenings completed by families linked to your program
- Message with families
- Share play-based activities
- Meet the developmental screening requirement of Ohio's revised Learning & Development quality rating standard

In addition to the ASQ-3, which considers skills from communication to fine and gross motor, families will also be able to complete the ASQ-SE, which explores social/emotional development. These

Once a completed ASQ is submitted via the Sparkler app, a Help Me Grow Developmental Screening Specialist will review the results and contact the family to share them. These conversations will offer parents support and/or connect them to valuable resources to ensure their child is getting all they need to thrive.

Just as the ASQ has expanded to serve Ohio children *through age 5*, the [Community Resource Directory](#) at [helpmegrow.org](http://helpmegrow.org) has also expanded to include resources for families with children through age 5.

Whether you're looking for diapers or preschools, you can search the directory and get results that also display on a map to help you easily see where resources are located. Entries can be shared easily via email or the link can be copied to put in a text message. Providers of listed resources can also submit changes if information needs to be updated.

The directory includes resources in all 88 Ohio counties. No matter where you live in Ohio, you can find resources in your neighborhood.
