## FALL 2024 ASSESSMENT WINDOW - DATA COLLECTION

The Fall ELA assessment window closed on November 14. Data must be uploaded to the site <https://www.ohio-k12.help/ela-score-entry-and-reporting/> by **December 6 at 11:59 p.m.** The same link also includes all the technical instructions for reporting this year.

## DO NOT REPORT ELA SCORES OR REASON CODES FOR MISSING SCORES IN EMIS

As a reminder, programs **will not** report ELA data in EMIS for the 2024-2025 school year. There are **no** reason codes to report for the ELA for missing scores this year. If you have a partially completed assessment for a child, you should enter the assessment data you have and leave blank the scores for items that were not assessed.

### SSIDs

Including every child's correct SSID with the ELA data submission is the best way to ensure the data is linked with other information including elements identifying children who are required to have the assessment data reported. However, ECE grantees that do not have the SSID information for one or more children should report the scores with the demographic information that is available. We will follow up with programs after the data collection closes if we need additional information to match a child's scores to their other information.
