What is the Community of Practice?

The Early Childhood Emergent Literacy Community of Practice is a 3-part, synchronous series to dive deeper into the content from our Early Childhood Emergent Literacy Module Series on <u>ALLOhio</u>. In these live sessions, participants will complete hands-on activities, discuss realworld examples, and collaborate with other early childhood **preschool professionals**. Prior to each session, participants will complete an online, self-paced module in which they will discover evidence-based practices for supporting young children's literacy development. Participants will also explore ways to incorporate these practices into their teaching and participate in group discussions online to deepen their learning.

What Will be Covered?

Each of the three live sessions will do deep-dive and application-based activities related to an online module. The three sessions will cover the following:

- 1. Phonological Awareness: The Why, What, and How
- 2. Print Knowledge: Thy Why and What
- 3. Print Knowledge: The How

Free OCCRRA credit is available.

Who is it for?

This Community of Practice opportunity is for practitioners serving preschool-aged children. Centers or districts will assemble a team of five teachers to participate.
