WHEREAS, in 2024, there were 14,764 confirmed reports of child abuse and/or neglect recorded in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, on average, there were more than 40 confirmed reports of child abuse and/or neglect in Ohio a day; and

WHEREAS, abuse and neglect can cause damage to children's physical, mental, and social development that affects the rest of their lives; and

WHEREAS, the effects of adverse childhood experiences, such as abuse, can impact brain development that affects long-term functions and can lead to a higher risk for chronic diseases; learning disorders; smoking; alcohol and substance abuse; teen pregnancy; juvenile delinquency; and adult criminal behavior; and

WHEREAS, these negative impacts may be substantially mitigated by having positive experiences such as a trusted adult supporter during one's childhood; and

WHEREAS, Ohio recognizes the collective impact of parents, family members, educators, public officials, and faith-based organizations who share the responsibility to protect our youth and to ensure that children are safe and can grow up without fear of abuse and neglect to realize their full potential; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Children's Trust Fund encourages Ohioans to raise awareness about the impact of child abuse and neglect and to recognize that children possess a unique ability to light up our lives and that we can all be a part of nurturing their bright spirit with love and care; and

WHEREAS, Ohio is committed to raising children in a secure and loving environment where they can thrive, develop character, and learn to be responsible citizens with the help of all Ohioans; and
