

To Obtain a Social Security Card

You'll need:

One proof of your identity

Documents accepted include:

- **U.S. driver's license** or non-driver's state-issued ID
- **U.S. passport** or passport card
- **Health insurance** or **Medicaid card** that shows the applicant's name and:
 - Photograph, or
 - Age, or
 - Date of birth

Medical record from a clinic, doctor, or hospital. Hospital bills, payment receipts, or admission letters are NOT accepted. The document must show:

- Applicant's name, and
- Age or date of birth, and
- A treat date within the last 2 years, and
- A signature or stamp from the medical provider

Employee ID that shows the applicant's name, and:

- Photograph, or
- Date of birth

U.S. military ID card

Certificate of Naturalization or U.S. Citizenship

One proof of Child's identity

Documents accepted include:

U.S. passport or passport card

Health insurance or **Medicaid card** that shows the applicant's name, and:

- Photograph, or
- Age, or
- Date of birth, or
- Parent's name

If the card only shows a name and photograph, the child must come to the office.

Immunization record from a clinic, doctor, or hospital that shows:

- Applicant's name, and
- Age or date of birth, and
- A treatment date within the last four year, and
- A signature or stamp from the medical provider

Medical record from a clinic, doctor, or hospital. Hospital bills, payment receipts, or admission letters are NOT accepted. The document must show:

- Applicant's name, and
- Age or date of birth, and
- A treat date within the last 2 years, and
- A signature or stamp from the medical provider

Documents must be:

- ✓ Original documents or certified copies with raised seal, stamp, or signature
- ✓ Unexpired

Documents cannot be:

- Photocopies
- Pictures
- Laminated
- Notarized copies
- Translated copies of original
