PROGRAM UPDATES

SFY26 45-Day Compliance

Activities related to the SFY26 45-Day baseline compliance analysis will begin soon. The EI Policy and Monitoring team is hosting a webinar on March 26 from 2:00 to 3:00 PM to review 45-Day timeline requirements, documentation needed to verify compliance of required activities, and how to prepare for the process.
