What problem are we trying to solve?

In this update, improvements to the look and feel of Traverse are being deployed. The changes will provide consistency between the Traverse web application and the recently launched updated mobile application. Traverse will feel simpler and easier to use.

What can you expect?

Traverse is getting a new user interface (UI) to make it look and feel more modern. As part of this release:

- *A new look and feel.*
- *A new design system (colors, typography, and components).*
- *A consistent visual foundation for Traverse.*

This release updated only the UI—not the user experience (UX). This means the way you navigate through Traverse was not restructured; nor was there the addition or removal of significant content from pages. There are not any brand-new features being deployed at this time.

Northwoods University will also be updated to ensure the content reflects the new UI.
