



# APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

10(B) DISPENSARY LICENSE

May 2024



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# I. INTRODUCTION

## Background

In November 2023, Ohio voters approved a citizen-initiated statute to legalize the possession, sale, and use of non-medical cannabis. That initiated statute established the Division of Cannabis Control (“Division” or “DCC”) within the Ohio Department of Commerce and requires the Division to issue applications for non-medical cannabis license by June 7, 2024, and issue licenses by September 7, 2024.

The initial licenses required by the initiated statute include:

1. Non-medical cannabis licenses for each current medical marijuana cultivator, processor, testing laboratory, and dispensary at the same location which they are currently operating. These licenses are referred to throughout these materials as “applications to convert a medical marijuana license” or “dual-use” licenses.
2. Additional dispensary licenses for new locations allocated to each current medical marijuana cultivator, as well as dispensaries that are not commonly owned or controlled by a cultivator or processor. These are referred to as “10(B) applications” or “10(B) licenses.”

This packet is for applications for 10(B) dispensary licenses.

## Eligibility

Pursuant to O.R.C. 3780.10(B), the following licenses (i.e., “10(B)” dispensary licenses) must be issued:

- **For a Level I medical marijuana cultivator with a certificate of operation or provisional license:** 3 dispensary licenses per entity at locations designated in a license application.
- **For a Level II medical marijuana cultivator with a certificate of operation or provisional license:** 1 dispensary license per entity at a location designated in a license application.
- **For a medical marijuana dispensary with a certificate of operation or provisional license, which does not have any common ownership or control with any cultivator or processor:** 1 dispensary license per entity at a location designated in a license application.

The Division will determine each entity that is eligible to apply for the “10(B)” dispensary licenses and the total number of “10(B)” dispensary licenses for which an entity is eligible.

- The entity determination and total number of eligible licenses is based upon a review of records obtained by the Division related to licensed medical marijuana entity common ownership and control.
- The Division will provide these determinations to licensed medical marijuana entities prior to accepting “10(B)” dispensary applications. Entities will then be provided with an opportunity to review the determinations and share any further relevant information with the Division.

An “eligible entity” means the current medical marijuana license that is eligible for a 10(B) dispensary license.

## Legal Authority

Applicants are advised to review Chapter [3796](#) and [3780](#) of the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C) as well as Chapter [3796](#) and proposed [1301:18](#) of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), and seek legal counsel where necessary.

## II. APPLICATION MATERIALS AND SUBMISSION

### Application Materials

In addition to this document, an FAQ is available at <https://com.ohio.gov/divisions-and-programs/cannabis-control/licensee-resources/applications>.

The Division will post the application, when available, on the website listed above. Please see Appendix A for a list of questions and information that will be required for submission on the application.

The complete 10(B) Application packet includes:

- Fillable PDF Application document
- 10(B) Applicant Attestation
- Tax Authorization Form
- \$5,000 application fee payment

**NOTE: The initial 10(B) application DOES NOT include facility site locations. Prior to the start of Phase One, the Division will publish a supplemental Facility Site Location Application, which will be completed after the drawing, at the start of Phase One.**

### Completing an Application

For an application to be considered complete, you must complete each question of the fillable PDF document and submit the completed 10(B) Applicant Attestation, Tax Authorization Form, and \$5,000 application fee.

Additional information or documentation may be attached. All documents responding to a single question must be combined into a single file. The contents of attachments must be clear and visibly labeled. All attachments must be saved with the naming convention “*Business Name – Applicant Confirmation Number – Question Number.*”

**The application fee must be paid (see “Fee” section below) and all three documents of the required application packet as well as any additional documentation must be submitted together, at one time, for the application to be considered complete.**

**NOTE:** The Confirmation Number provided in the entity eligibility letter sent via email to each entity eligible to apply for a 10(B) license must be included on the application for the application to be considered complete.

#### 10(B) Dispensary Business Legal Name

The business legal name for a 10(B) dispensary must either be the same legal entity that is eligible for the 10(B) license OR a subsidiary entity of the eligible entity and only if the subsidiary entity has the identical ownership, officers, board members, and persons with control as the eligible entity.

## Fee

Pursuant to O.A.C. 1301:18-2-06, there is a \$5,000 application fee per 10(B) license application. The application fee will be assessed to the DCC eLicense account of the medical marijuana license which made the applicant eligible for a 10(B) dispensary license.

### FOR EXAMPLE:

#1. I am a Level One cultivator and am eligible for three 10(B) dispensary licenses. Three separate \$5,000 application fees will be assessed to my Level One cultivator license within DCC eLicense.

#2. I am a Level Two cultivator and am eligible for one 10(B) dispensary licenses. One \$5,000 application fee will be assessed to my Level Two cultivator license within DCC eLicense.

#3. I have three dispensaries with no common ownership or control with a cultivator or processor, and therefore I am eligible for three 10(B) dispensary licenses. One \$5,000 application fee will be assessed to each of my three dispensary licenses within DCC eLicense.

The fee can be paid directly in the DCC eLicense portal via ACH or credit card. More information about how to make a payment can be found in the [eLicense Portal User Manual](#) beginning on page 33.

## Submitting an Application

On Friday, June 7 at 8:00am ET, the Division will begin accepting applications for 10(B) dispensary licenses. The complete application and related materials may be submitted in one of two ways. The instructions below must be followed for an application submission to be considered:

### Option 1:

- Email the complete application packet to [DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov](mailto:DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov) with the subject line "*Business Name – Applicant Confirmation Number – 10(B) Dispensary Application.*" This email address can accept up to 150 MB of attachments.

OR

### Option 2:

- Step 1: Drop the complete application packet in the State of Ohio File Drop here: <https://filedrop.cloudfs.ohio.gov/>.
  - Must enter the recipient email as [DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov](mailto:DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov).
- Step 2: Email [DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov](mailto:DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov) **after** submitting your files, with the subject line "*Business Name – Applicant Confirmation Number – 10(B) Dispensary Application,*" and indicate that your files have been submitted in the File Drop.

You will receive an automatic response from [DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov](mailto:DCCApplications@com.ohio.gov) that your email has been received. If you do not receive this response, check your "junk" or "spam" folder.

**Complete initial applications are due on or before 5:00pm ET on June 14, 2024.**

**Applications will not be accepted in any other form of submission, including any other file share, file drops, or FTPs.**

### III. INITIAL APPLICATION REVIEW & DRAWING

#### Initial Application Review

Upon submission of a complete application by June 14, 2024<sup>1</sup> (see Section II above), the applicant will be entered into the drawing with the number of entries corresponding to their selection of dual-use or adult-use only license. See “Drawing” information below.

If an application is incomplete, the Division will notify the applicant of the deficiencies and the applicant will be provided with 10 days to cure the deficiencies and submit the complete application packet again.

**To be entered into the drawing, the eligible entity must submit a complete application by 5:00pm on June 14, 2024.** If a complete application is not received by that time, the eligible entity may not be entered into the drawing and cannot participate in Phase One site selection. The Division may request additional information from applicants.

Any complete applications received after 5:00pm on June 14, 2024, but prior to a date established by the Division, may not be entered into the drawing and be entered into Phase Two site selection. The applicants will be entered into Phase Two at the bottom of the drawing rank, in the order in which completed applications were received.

#### Drawing

##### Ohio Lottery Commission Drawing

In an effort to provide applicants with time to understand the drawing process, the Division is providing the below information. However, please note that these processes and procedures are subject to change. The Division will post final information on its website prior to the drawing.

The drawing will be conducted by the Ohio Lottery Commission (“Lottery”) on Friday, June 21, 2024<sup>2</sup>.

The Division will assign a number to each entry into the drawing. The Lottery will be given a list of numbers only from the Division for the total number of entries into the drawing. The Lottery will not be given any information identifying applicants or associating any applicants with a specific number.

The Lottery will use their Random Number Generator technology to randomly assign rank to the list of numbers.

The Lottery will certify the results and provide them to the Division. The Division will then organize the list of applicants that were previously assigned to each of the numbers.

Concurrent with the start of the Lottery drawing, the Division will post the list on its website showing both the list of numbers provided to the Lottery and the applicant assigned to each number.

In a reasonable amount of time upon receiving the certified results from Lottery, the Division will post a list of the rankings on its website and notify applicants.

A video recording of the drawing will be made available following the drawing.

The Lottery Commission utilizes a licensed Auditor to verify each drawing and the result.

#### Number of Entries

Each applicant will be entered into the drawing for each “10(B)” dispensary license for which they are eligible.

If an applicant designated their “10(B)” dispensary license as dual-use on the application, they will be entered into the drawing with twice the chance per license of a higher ranking.

#### FOR EXAMPLE:

ABC Corp. is eligible for three dispensaries. ABC Corp. indicated on their application that two dispensaries will be dual-use and one will be adult-use only. When ABC Corp.’s dispensaries are entered into the drawing, the two that will be dual-use will each be entered into the drawing twice for the chance at a higher ranking. The one dispensary that is adult-use only will only be entered into the drawing once. For the dual-use licenses that are entered twice, the higher ranked position will be selected as their final ranking.

Being entered into the drawing twice is only for purposes of the chance at a higher ranking – it does not affect the total number of licenses for which an entity is eligible.

For a dual-use license with two entries, the Division will automatically accept the higher ranking for the applicant and the lower ranking will be discarded.

## IV. Phases One and Two – Site Selection

### Phase One

Following the drawing, Phase One will begin on July 1, 2024.<sup>3</sup>

#### Phase One: Round One

1. Each eligible entity authorized to apply will have **one** 10(B) license eligible for Phase One facility site selection. The Division will provide a Facility Site Location Application, which must be utilized to submit site selections to the Division.
  - a. A facility site location application must indicate a primary site location selection and may indicate up to two additional selections that will be chosen, by order of preference, if the primary site location is ineligible.
  - b. No proposed dispensary may be within one mile radius of an existing dispensary or another proposed dispensary site.
2. The Division will review all site selections and determine if any are within one mile of an existing dispensary or another proposed dispensary site.
  - a. If a proposed dispensary site is within one mile of an existing dispensary, the applicant must select another site.
  - b. If two or more proposed dispensary sites are within one mile of each other, the entity(ies) that had the lower drawing rank will move to their next preferred site as designated in their Facility Site Location Application.
3. The Division will publish the location of selected sites approved and notify applicants who must select a new site.

#### Phase One: Round Two

4. Applicants that did not have a site approved in Round One will be provided additional time to select a new site.
5. At the end of that timeframe (Round Two), the Division will review the new proposed sites and determine if any are within one mile of an existing dispensary or another proposed dispensary site.
  - a. If a proposed facility site is within one mile of an existing dispensary, the applicant must select another site.
  - b. If two or more proposed dispensary sites are within one mile of each other the entity(ies) that had the lower drawing rank will move to their next preferred site as designated in their Facility Site Location Application.

#### Phase One: Round Three

6. If any applicants remain that did not have a dispensary site approved in Rounds One or Two, the DCC may proceed with additional Rounds following the same process described above.
  - a. Any applicants who did not submit a new site within the previous timeframe may do so at this time.

7. At the deadline for Phase One as established by the Division, the process will move on to Phase Two.
8. Should any applicants not have an approved location at the conclusion of Phase One, the site selection process for that facility will move to Phase Two.

## Phase Two

1. The Division will publish a list of applicants and their associated number of “10(B)” dispensary licenses remaining for Phase Two.
2. The Division will establish and make publicly available regional districts throughout the state, and the total number of licenses available in each regional district.
  - a. When establishing the regional districts, the DCC will consider factors such as locations of current or proposed dispensaries and anticipated demand for medical and non-medical cannabis, population, geography, and other factors.
  - b. A dispensary will not be permitted to relocate outside of their assigned regional district.
3. Eligible applicants must submit their preferred regional districts to the Division for each license on the form prescribed by the Division.
4. Applicants will be notified of their assigned regional districts based on the randomly assigned rank established by the prior drawing.

### Phase Two: Round One

5. Applicants must then submit to the Division their proposed dispensary facility site within the assigned regional district, on the Facility Site Location Application established by the Division.
  - a. A Facility Site Location Application must indicate a primary site location selection and may indicate up to two additional selections that will be chosen, by order of preference, if the primary site location is ineligible.
  - b. If a proposed dispensary site is within one mile of an existing dispensary or a site selected during Phase One, the applicant must select another site.
  - c. If two or more proposed dispensary sites are within one mile of each other, the entity that had the lower drawing rank will move to their next preferred site as designated in their Facility Site Location Application.
6. The Division will publish the location of selected sites approved and notify applicants who must select a new site.

### Phase Two: Round Two

7. Applicants that did not have a site approved in Round One will be provided additional time to select a new site.
8. At the end of that timeframe (Round Two), the Division will review the proposed sites and determine if there are any within one mile of an existing dispensary, a previously approved site, or another proposed dispensary site.
  - a. If a proposed dispensary site is within one mile of an existing dispensary, the applicant must select another site.

- b. If two or more proposed dispensary sites are within one mile of each other, the entity(ies) that had the lower drawing rank will move to their next preferred site as designated in their Facility Site Location Application.

### Phase Two: Round Three

9. If any applicants remain that did not have a dispensary site approved in Rounds One or Two, the DCC may proceed with additional Rounds following the same process described above.
  - a. Any applicants who did not submit a new site within the previous timeframe may do so at this time.
9. All applicants who have submitted a completed application and approved dispensary site will move into the review process prior to issuance of a provisional license.

## Facility Site Location Application

**The Division will publish the Facility Site Location Application prior to the start of Phase One. A Facility Site Location Application may not be submitted before Phase One begins.**

The Facility Site Location Application will be a fillable PDF document. The applicant must indicate a primary site location selection and may indicate up to two additional selections that will be chosen, by order of preference, if the primary site location is ineligible.

The applicant may identify the site location selection by street address or geographic coordinates. If the applicant submits a street address, the Division will utilize software to obtain the geographic coordinates. If submitting geographic coordinates, the applicant must ensure the coordinates are located within the existing or planned facility, not simply located on the parcel.

The “one-mile buffer” is a radius from the proposed facility site location, measured linearly (i.e., as the crow flies) using geographic coordinates (i.e., latitude and longitude).

A single set of coordinates for the proposed dispensary will be used to calculate the distance to the closest existing dispensary based on a single set of coordinates for that existing dispensary.

Prior to the start of Phase One, the Division will publish a list of geographic coordinates for existing dispensaries, and information about the technology used to obtain geographic coordinates from a submitted address and how the distance between dispensaries is measured.

## V. Provisional Licensing

Once a dispensary site location is approved in Phase One or Phase Two above, the Division will review the following for compliance with Division rules prior to issuing a provisional license.

### Site Control

**Within 45 days** of approval of a site location pursuant to Phase One or Phase Two, an applicant must demonstrate control of the approved site location.

The Division will consider site control established if the applicant owns the property or has an active lease for the property where the property owner has acknowledged the nature of the business proposed for the site and has agreed to allow the applicant as a tenant.

Site control may also be established by other documentation (e.g., Letter of Intent), if the documentation provides:

- That the applicant approved by the Division for that site is the entity that is permitted exclusively to operate a cannabis business at the facility site location pursuant to the LOI or other agreement.
  - This means that more than one applicant may have a LOI or other agreement with the property owner; however, the agreement must ensure that the entity approved by the Division for that site has the right to operate at the site location.
- And, that the terms of the agreement may not be altered as a condition of allowing the entity to occupy the property and operate a cannabis business at the site location.

### Local Zoning

**Within 45 days** of approval of a site location pursuant to Phase One or Phase Two, an applicant must demonstrate that there are no local moratoriums or other limitations in place that would prevent them from occupying the proposed dispensary site.

Evidence of local zoning must be provided on a form prescribed by the Division. The Division will publish the form, when available, on its website.

### Prohibited Facilities Compliance

Pursuant to O.R.C. [3780.07](#), no facility shall be located within 500 feet of the end boundaries of a parcel of real estate having situated on it a prohibited facility. Pursuant to O.R.C. 3780.01, a "prohibited facility" means any church, public library, public playground, public park, or school, as defined in section 3796.30 of the Revised Code.

**Within 45 days** of approval of a site location pursuant to Phase One or Phase Two, the Division will determine compliance with O.R.C. 3780.07.

## Relocation Requests

Pursuant to proposed O.A.C. 1301:18-2-06(L), the Division may consider a request to relocate a proposed dispensary due to circumstances outside the control of the applicant. Such circumstances may include:

1. Enactment of a local moratorium **after** the submission of a Facility Site Location Application.
2. Unilateral revocation by the property owner for use of the premises of the selected facility site (e.g., property owner has not met the terms, or materially altered the terms, of their agreement, without consent of the applicant).
3. Establishment of a prohibited facility within 500 feet of the proposed site **after** the submission of a Facility Site Location Application.

## Provisional License Issuance

Once the applicant has met the requirements specified above or in subsequent guidance from the Division, the applicant will be issued a provisional license in DCC eLicense.

## VI. DISCLOSURE OF APPLICANT INFORMATION

The Applicant understands that the Department of Commerce, Division of Cannabis Control is an entity of the State of Ohio and any documents or data submitted to the State of Ohio may be disclosed by the State pursuant to an Ohio Public Records Act request.

While the Ohio Public Records Act permits certain exclusions from disclosure, Applicant understands the State makes no guarantee or promises that such data will not be disclosed. Applicant has reviewed the Ohio Public Records Act, as well as relevant case law.

Applicant understands that the documents or data it provides to the State of Ohio may not be confidential, or if confidential, may or may not be disclosed pursuant to an Ohio Public Records Act request.

Applicant understands that there are additional requirements in order to claim a trade secret or infrastructure record exception. Applicant understands that materials consisting of trade secrets or infrastructure records must be clearly marked, specifying the pages of the application submission that are to be restricted and justifying the trade secret designation or infrastructure designation for each item.
