LICENSEE GUIDANCE & RESOURCES

The Division of Cannabis Control (DCC or Division) will issue the first dual-use dispensary Certificates of Operation on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, allowing those dispensaries to begin selling non-medical cannabis. A licensee may only begin non-medical sales on the effective date referenced in the Notice of Intent to Issue a Certificate of Operation. The printable Certificate of Operation issued in eLicense will follow. Licensees are not authorized to begin non-medical sales until the date indicated on their Notice of Intent.

The DCC is reminding licensees of the guidance issued by the Division and resources available to licensees.
