FINDING ACCEPTABLE CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR THE DENTAL RADIOGRAPHER CERTIFICATE RENEWAL

Do a Google search: "dental radiology continuing education"

The course must be a minimum of two hours in length.

Verify the Sponsor of the course is approved:

Continuing education programs may be developed and offered to dental x-ray machine operators by any of the following agencies or organizations:

(1) National, state, district, or local <u>dental associations</u> affiliated with the American dental association ADA or National dental association NDA;

ADA CERP – American Dental Association – Continuing Education Recognition Program

AGD PACE – Academy of General Dentistry – Program Approval for Continuing Education

(2) National, state, district, or local <u>dental hygienists' associations</u> affiliated with the American dental hygienists' association ADHA;

(3) National, state, district, or local <u>dental assistants associations</u> affiliated with the American dental assistants association ADAA;

(4) Accredited dental colleges or schools;

(5) Accredited dental hygiene colleges or schools;

(6) Other organizations, schools, paraprofessional programs, or agencies approved by the state dental board.

Verify the content/subject matter of the course is acceptable: (2 CE hours are required)

Continuing radiation technology programs include, <u>but are not limited to</u>, programs that address any of the following:

- (1) Radiation physics;
- (2) Radiation biology;
- (3) Radiation health, safety and protection;
- (4) X-ray films and radiographic film quality;
- (5) Radiographic techniques, processing and storage
