The identified race categories may add to more than the total population and their percentages may add to more than 100 percent because individuals may report more than one race.⁴ The U.S. Census Bureau edited same-sex spouse responses during processing to "unmarried partner." Family households consist of a householder and one or more people related by birth, marriage, or adoption. They do not include same-sex married couples even if legally recognized. Same-sex households are only included in the family households category if there is a least one additional person related to the householder by birth or adoption.⁵ The homeowner vacancy rate is the proportion of the homeowner inventory that is vacant "for sale". It is computed by dividing the total number of vacant units that are "for sale only" by the sum of owner-occupied units, vacant units that are for sale only, and vacant units sold but not occupied, multiplied by 100.⁶ The rental vacancy rate is the proportion of the rental inventory that is vacant "for rent". It is computed by dividing the total number of vacant units that are "for rent" by the sum of renter-occupied units, vacant units that are "for rent only", and vacant units rented but not occupied, multiplied by 100.
