Contents

This data series covers aspects of net migration from July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2024. Net migration is calculated by subtracting out-migrants from in-migrants. Migration occurs when there is a change of usual residence between clearly defined geographic units - for this report, those are the state and the 88 counties. Net domestic-internal and international migration figures are combined into net summary figures. Net international migration includes the migration of both U.S.-born and non-U.S.-born populations between the defining entities: the 50 states and District of Columbia as one entity, and foreign countries and U.S. territories collectively as the other entity.

July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2024.

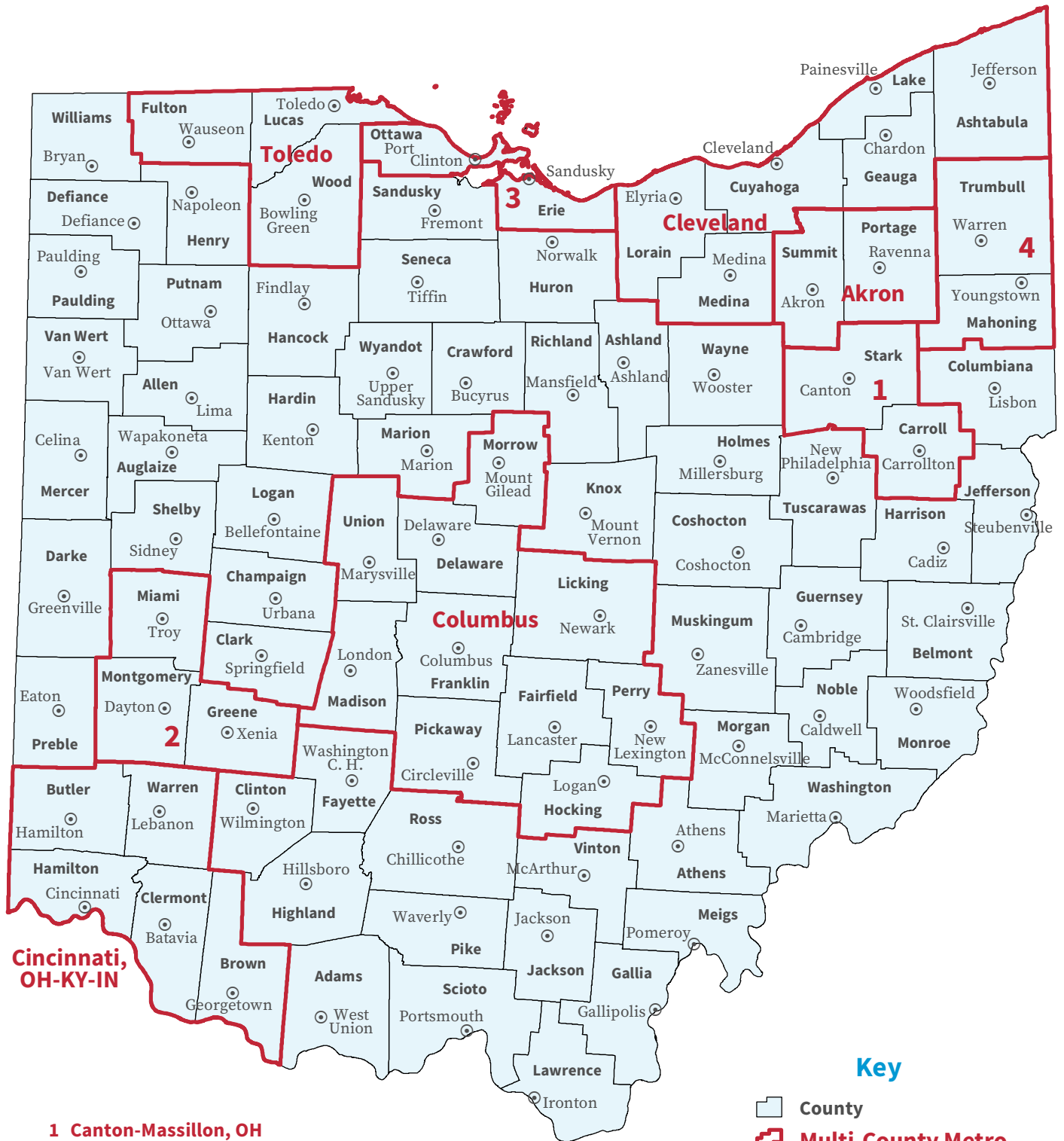

Ohio Counties, County Seats and Multi-County Metropolitan Areas*



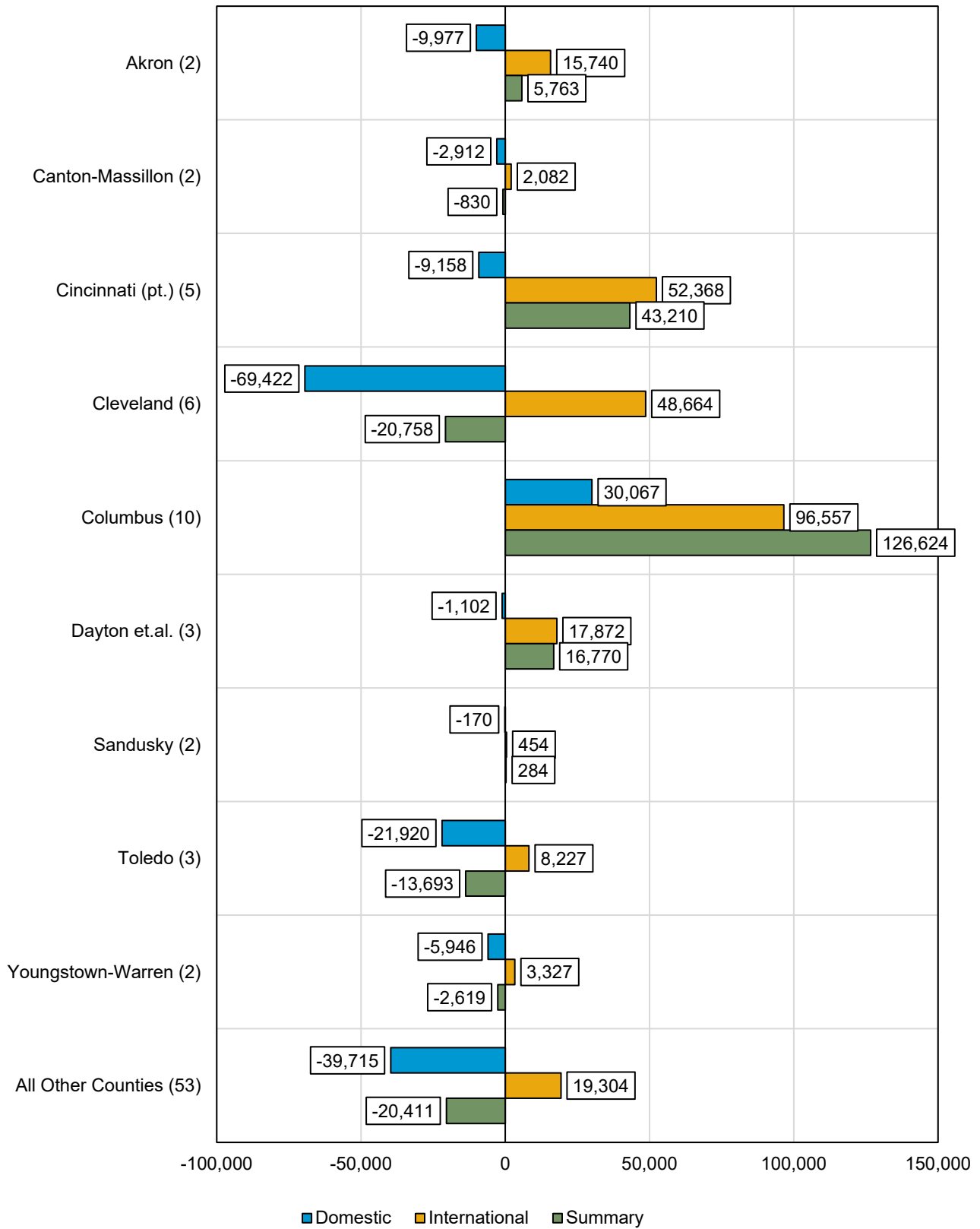
