What

How to Participate

- Use your phone to record a 15-30 second video of you sharing about the dad in your family
 - » Feel free to use any form of communication: Spoken language, ASL, Communication Devices, etc. If using placards, please make sure letters are large and bold, and held up for at least one second per word on the card.
- Suggestions of things you might want to share about:
 - » What you love about him?
 - » What he means to you?
 - » Why you are thankful for him?
- End your video by saying "Happy Fathers Day!"

How to Submit

- Subject line of your email: *Father's Day Recording - [your name]*
- Videos are due by **May 31, 2024**
- Important: *Videos may be used on the DODD social media, newsletters, or other public-facing channels, and by submitting, you are consenting to DODD using your video.*

Some Details and Helpful Tips

When sharing, please do not include:

- Personal information.
- Personal details about you or your family.
- Where you live.

Tips for taking a video using a camera phone:

- Turn phone horizontally (long ways) to record.
- Keep the camera at eye level about 5 feet away.
- Prop the camera on something so it doesn't shake.
- Record in a quiet place with no background noise.
- Use sunlight to your advantage. Face a window or bright light source, or go outside during an overcast day.
- Don't zoom in- use the standard camera.
- Take a test video, and watch the final video before submitting it: does it look good? Do you like what you said? Can you see and/or hear yourself well?
