### License Requirements

- 1) Each Certified E-Check Repair Facility shall employ at least one E-Check Certified Repair Technician.
- 2) Ohio EPA shall be immediately notified of changes in facility location, name, and/or ownership.
- 3) Each Certified E-Check Repair Facility shall display the official sign in full view of the public. The sign shall not be altered in any way and shall remain the property of Ohio EPA.
- 4) Each Certified E-Check Repair Facility shall notify Ohio EPA within seven days in writing when an E-Check Certified Repair Technician leaves employment at that facility.
- 5) Certified E-Check Repair Facilities shall comply with Chapter 3745-26 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

**Chapter 3745-26-15(G) of the Ohio Administrative Code requires the following equipment for a site to be a Certified E Check Repair Facility. These items must be available and in full operating condition:**

(1) Current reference materials.	(6) Scan tool.
(2) DVOM or digital multi-meter.	(7) Ignition scope with DIS capabilities.
(3) Vacuum gauge.	(8) Lab scope.
(4) Fuel pressure test kit.	(9) Purge flow tester.
(5) Carbon cleaner system.	(10) Scan tool with OBD II capabilities.
