## 20 DAY NOTICE OF SUSPENSION TO COMPLY WITH E-CHECK REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) 4503.103, your license plate(s) and registration must have an annual E-Check certification on file with the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) or your vehicle registration will be subject to a suspension for non-compliance.

This letter is notification that the E-Check requirement, on the above vehicle(s), must be completed twenty (20) days from the date of this letter. If the BMV does not receive the certification within that time, your vehicle registration will be automatically suspended.

After twenty (20) days from the date of this letter, your registration will be officially suspended and your license plates and registration must be surrendered or confiscated. In order to surrender license plate(s) and registration, please mail all items to the address below: Please note: BMV Deputy Registrar license agencies cannot accept your surrendered license plate(s).
