SENTENCE ENTRY

Defendant entered a plea of (GUILTY) (NO CONTEST) to the (STATED) (AMENDED) charge of 2 Charges; both M-Viol of NPPDES Permits in violation of Section 6111.07C. At the request of the prosecutor the following counts are dismissed:

- (X) Based upon the (DEFENDANT'S STIPULATION) / (COURT FINDING), there are sufficient facts to find defendant guilty, and the Court finds defendant guilty.
() Court accepts the defendant's guilty plea, and the Court finds the defendant guilty.

Having considered the principles of sentencing outlined in R.C. 2929.21 and the factors set forth in R.C. 2929.22, the following sentence is imposed:

FINE:
\$2000 Fine and court costs. Suspend \$ of the fine/costs for (X) Time payments authorized
IN ACCORDANCE WITH R.C. 2947.14, THE COURT MAKES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS:

- (X) Per defendant's own statement, he/she is able to pay the fine/costs imposed by 4-2-19.
If fine or costs not paid, refer for collections, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 2935.27(D) or 4510.22(A) the Court declares the forfeiture of the defendant's driver's license or commercial license. Pursuant to R.C. 1901.44(B), clerk to notify Bureau of Motor Vehicles of block on registration or transfer of registration.
() Pursuant to R.C. 2947.14, the Court finds defendant unable to pay.
() Pursuant to R.C. 2929.28, defendant shall perform hours community service by in the FCMC Community Cleanup Program.

In accordance with R.C. 2929.28(D), judgment is hereby rendered against defendant for the financial sanctions imposed above.

RESTITUTION: (To be paid through the clerk of courts) Investigated
() Pay restitution to victim: Ohio EPA Special Unit in the amount of \$ 1000.00
The amount of restitution is an order in favor of the victim that may be collected through civil remedies. R.C. 2929.28(D), which would include legal interest and costs. The Clerk is directed to assign Defendant's payments to the restitution order until paid in full before assigning payments to court costs, state fees or costs, fines, and reimbursements. R.C. 2949.111. If restitution has not been paid in full and court costs, state fees or costs, fines, and reimbursements are not paid by the enforcement date, the case is to be referred to the assigned Judge. Note: A to pay Clerk \$3000 = \$2000 shall be applied to A's fine. The Clerk shall send \$1000 to the Ohio Attorney General for restitution owed to the Ohio EPA.

JAIL TERM:
180 Total days in FCCC. Credit days for time served. Suspend 180 days upon the following conditions:

- () Length of confinement days in Enforcement date Release date
() Defendant's completion of hours of Community Service in the FCMC - Community Cleanup Program. By
() Defendant provides verification of compliance to the Chief Environmental Specialist prior to enforcement date.
() Provided No Convictions for serious traffic offenses / criminal offenses / same or similar offenses for year(s)
() Community Control. (X) Non-Reporting Community Sanction

- () Probation fee waived. () Probation fee capped at \$
