PSI has changed the exam scheduling platform we are using. If the last application you submitted for an examination was prior to January 16, 2024, then you will need to create a new account. You can register using the same email address and last name that you previously used when applying. Once you have reestablished an account you will be able to schedule your examination. Terms and Conditions

Please read the following statement carefully:

- To be admitted to any examination, I will be required to provide identification. The identification must be a current, permanent identification card issued by a governmental agency, which includes both signature and photograph. Only a driver's license (not temporary), state/province or federally issued I.D., military I.D. or passport will be accepted.
- A second form of identification as specified in my candidate handbook or on the on-line confirmation page must include my name and signature to allow verification of the signature on the first form.
- If my name is different than it appears on either form of identification, I will bring proof of my name change (i.e., marriage license, divorce decree or court order) to the Assessment Center.
- I understand that PSI will require me to sign the Assessment Center Roster prior to my admittance into any examination session.
- I agree not to divulge any information concerning the content of the examination to any party, and I agree not to attempt to copy or remove any of the examination materials from the test center. If a security violation occurs, I understand that my score may be invalidated.
- During my testing process, I understand I will be required to provide biometric verification of my identity. Biometric identification may include photograph, fingerprint scan, or other. I understand my testing session is also subject to video surveillance. I understand if I do not agree to these conditions, I will be excused from the Assessment Center and my testing fee will not be refunded.

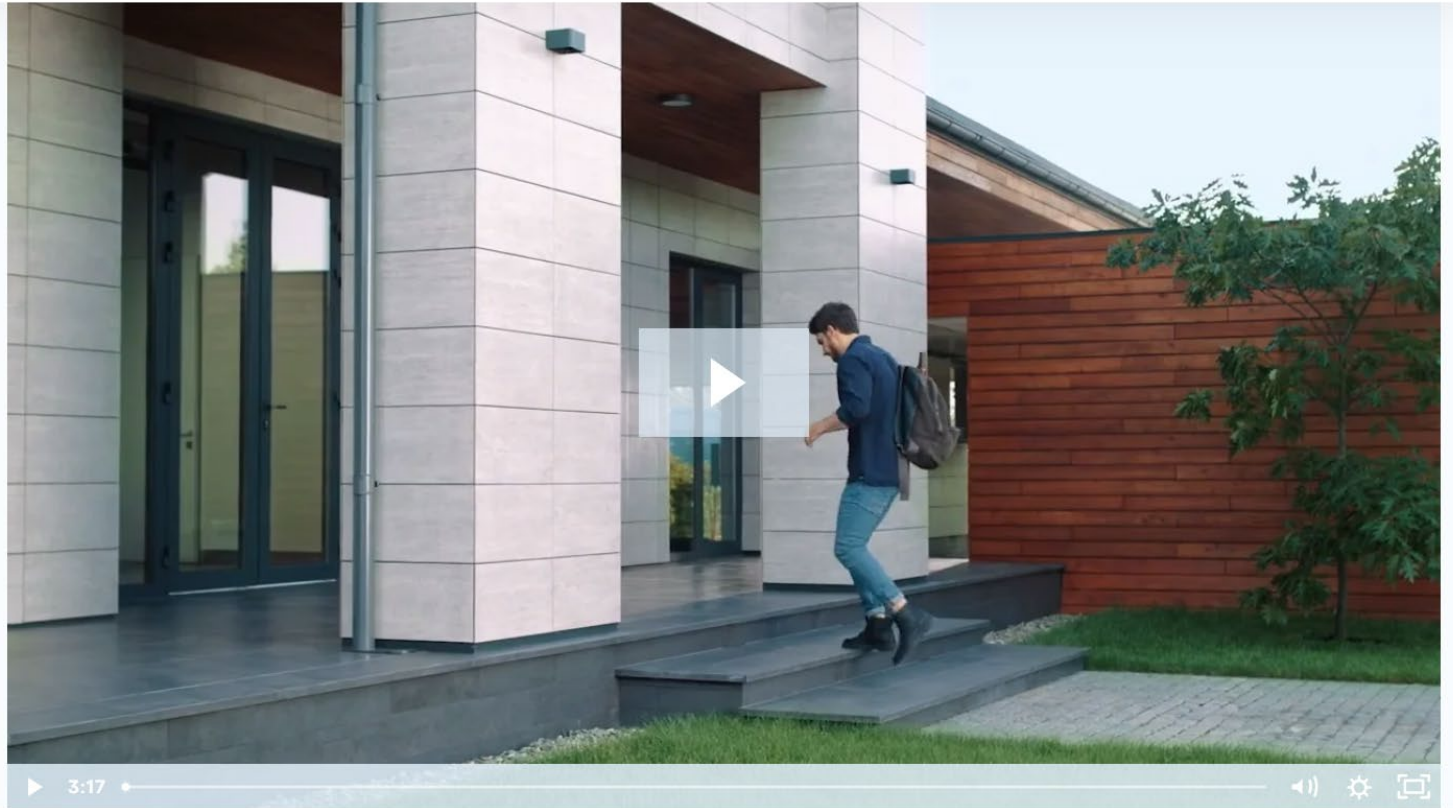

Certification Examination Information

The Ohio EPA certification examination is administered at more than 300 PSI Test Centers geographically located throughout the United States. A current listing of PSI Test Centers, including addresses and driving directions, may be viewed at <https://test-takers.psiexams.com/abc-oh>. The examinations are administered by appointment only, Monday through Saturday.

Examination Specifications

The Ohio EPA Water and Wastewater examinations (with the exception of the Water Supply Class A and the Wastewater Treatment Class A examinations - *please see chart below*) consist of 110 multiple-choice items, 100 of which are used to compute your score. In addition to the scored questions, the examination includes 10 non-scored items that are being "pretested" for use in future versions of the examination. These pretest questions are interspersed throughout the examination, and your answers to them do not affect your score.

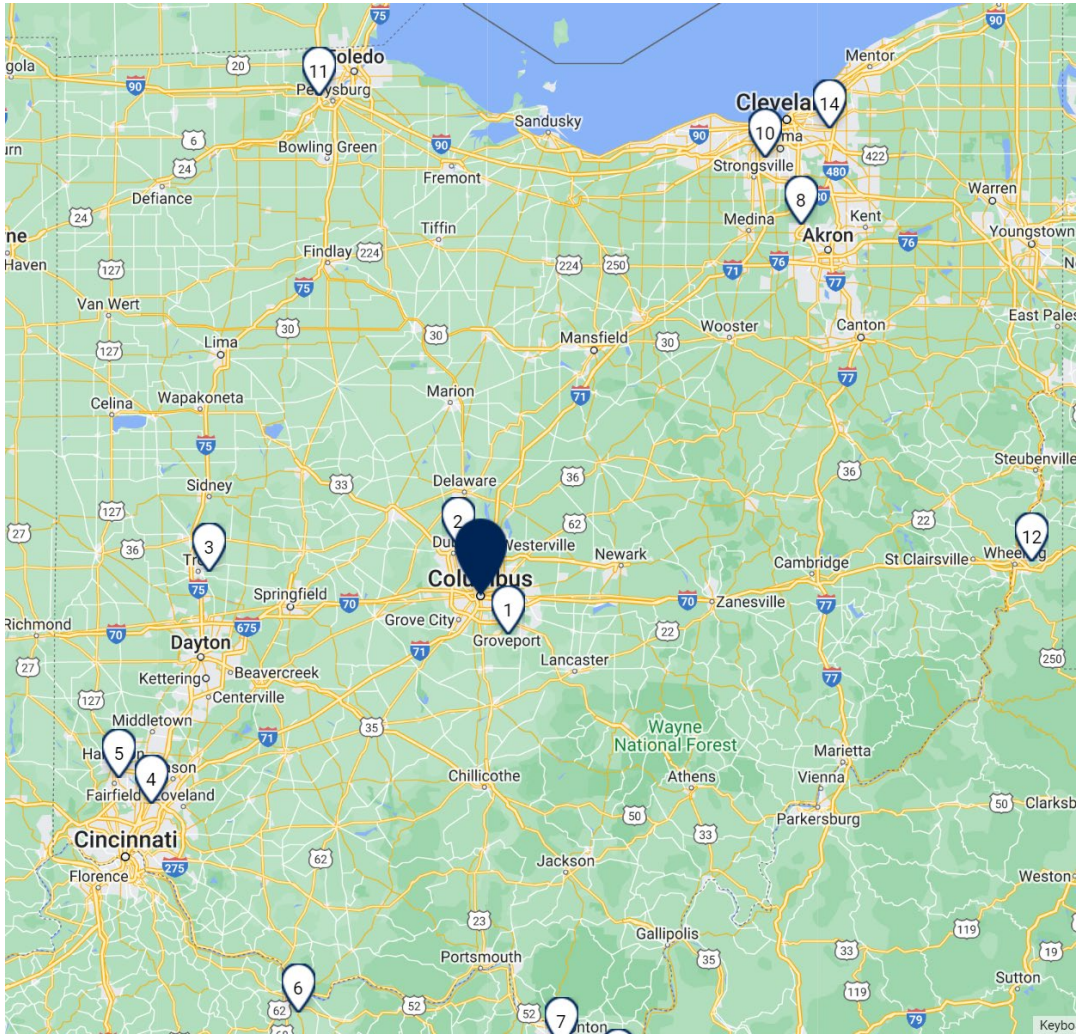
