Ohio Environmental Education Fund (OEEF) grants provide up to \$50,000 for programs that:

- Help small businesses and farmers understand environmental regulations;
- Teach Ohio residents what they can do to protect Ohio's air, water and land;
- Provide science supplies and opportunities for Ohio students to monitor air and water quality, explore careers in the environmental sciences and engineering.



Education funding priority topics:

- Innovative storm water management
- Reducing air emissions
- Encouraging habitat restoration
- Reducing nutrient pollution in rivers and streams
- Explore careers in the environmental sciences and engineering

Grant Amounts and Duration:

General Grants

\$500 - \$50,000
24 months to complete

Mini Grants

\$500 - \$5,000
12 months to complete
