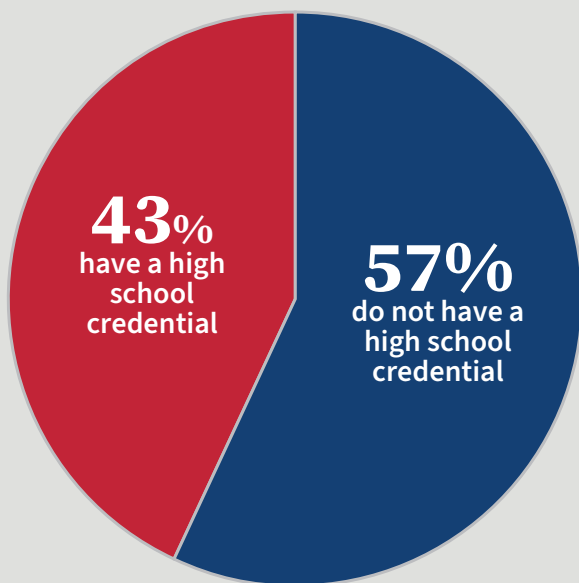
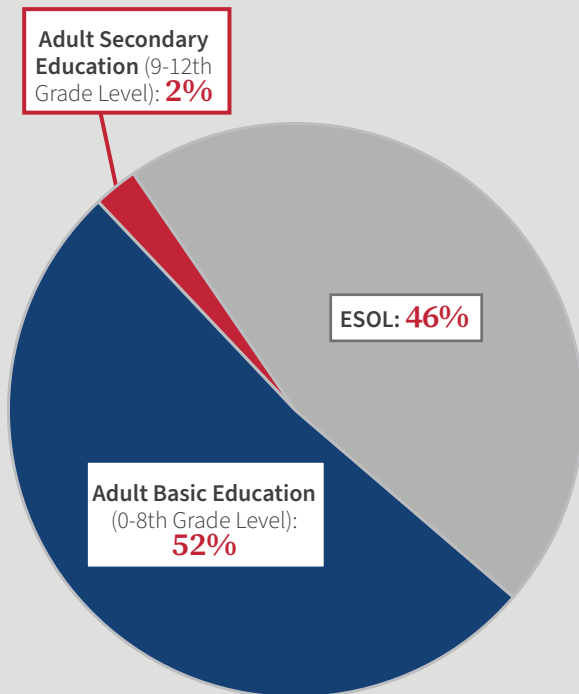

Annual Expenditure per Student

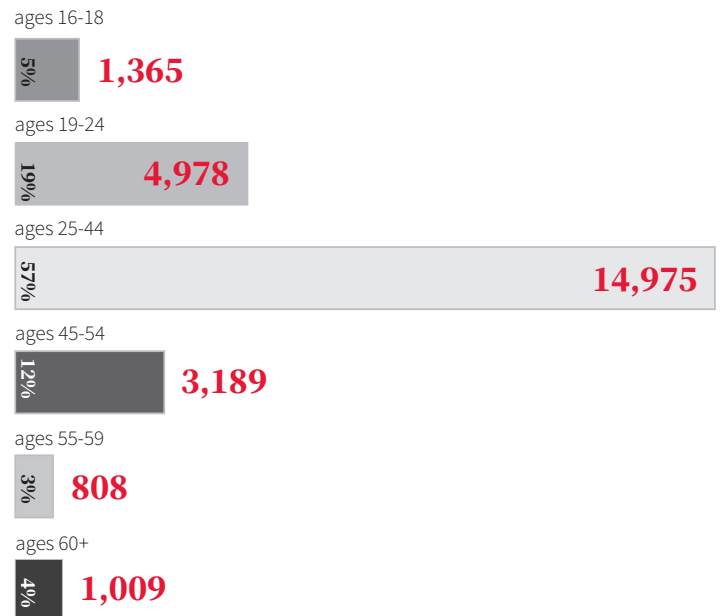
