Recommendation:

The above listed Youngstown State University preparation program have been reviewed using the 2018 Literacy Standards which meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for Educator Preparation programs.

Approval is recommended until the Fall 2029 review cycle, contingent upon submission of all corresponding literacy course syllabi's with applicable crosswalk by the Spring 2025 review cycle demonstrating alignment with the updated 2023 Literacy Standards.

The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw approval or require an additional review if Youngstown State University fails to meet the Chancellor's standards for Educator Preparation programs or fails to receive accreditation from the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) or the Association for Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation (AAQEP).

Profile:

Youngstown State University is a public university that was founded in 1908. The university has a specific mission to help students grow intellectually, and to foster their personal, social, emotional, and career growth, as well as their capacities for lifelong learning, civic responsibility, and leadership. Located in Youngstown, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 11,000 undergraduate and over 1,000 graduate students.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Youngstown State University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2028. Youngstown State University's educator preparation programs are accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) until its next scheduled review in Fall 2024.
