Profile:

Ursuline College is a private, non-profit college founded by the Ursuline Sisters of Cleveland that was founded in 1871. The college has a specific mission to offer holistic education that transforms students for service, leadership and professional excellence by providing undergraduate and graduate programs that foster lifelong learning and personal wisdom. Located in Pepper Pike, Ohio, the college has an enrollment of around 950 students across undergraduate and graduate programs.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Ursuline College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) and is currently transitioning to a new accreditor. Ursuline College's educator preparation programs are accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) until Spring 2028. Ursuline College is currently participating in a merger with Gannon University, in Erie, Pennsylvania. Ursuline College is approved to continue approved programs through Spring 2028.
