Private Employer Policy Year 2023 Notice

In late April and early May, BWC will begin mailing information regarding the Estimated Annual Premium for the policy year beginning July 1, 2023. The letter will include the payroll estimate, installment schedule, and premium information for the next policy year. It will also include an updated certificate of coverage for active policies.

The annual notice is not a bill and installments should not be made upon receiving the notice. An invoice will be mailed on June 1, 2023.
