WHEREAS, Ohio ranks third in the nation for the number of manufacturing jobs, with more than 688,000, or more than one in eight, Ohio jobs in manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, Ohio ranks first in the nation for employment in plastics and rubber manufacturing and glass and glass product manufacturing and second in the nation for employment in primary metal manufacturing, machinery manufacturing, and electrical equipment, appliance, and component manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, OhioMeansJobs.com currently lists more than 1,000 open manufacturing positions, and the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services oversees both OhioMeansJobs.com and the state's local OhioMeansJobs Centers, where Ohioans can get help exploring manufacturing careers and finding manufacturing jobs; and

WHEREAS, there are manufacturing jobs for every level of education, from high school through four-year or even advanced degrees; and

WHEREAS, average manufacturing incomes exceed \$70,000 a year, and some manufacturing jobs pay over \$100,000 a year; and

WHEREAS, opportunities are available for computer programmers, engineers, electrical technicians, industrial machinery mechanics, and many more occupations; and

WHEREAS, Ohioans can view a complete list of in-demand manufacturing occupations at topjobs.ohio.gov.


