SUBJECT: Safe Sleep Kit Ordering Instructions

Background

Beginning May 2022, Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) and Ohio Department of Health (ODH) collaborated to further promote safe sleep education to all ODJFS certified resource caregivers. According to data from ODH, each week in Ohio, three babies perish in unsafe sleep environments, and we know that your team is continuing to educate your certified resource caregivers on the importance of safe sleep practices. Each month, ODJFS sends safe sleep education materials to all newly certified resource caregivers for all public and private agencies in Ohio. ODH guest speakers joined us for our OFC Bi-Monthly Touchpoint meeting on March 15, 2023, and shared data and resources to support your agency in further promoting safe sleep education with your certified foster caregivers.

Safe Sleep Kits

To support you in these efforts, beginning in March 2023, our partners at ODH have made a Safe Sleep Educational Kit available for both public and private resource caregivers after becoming initially certified. This Safe Sleep Kit offers tools and resources to complement their knowledge gained in pre-service training as well as in your agency's onboarding policy.
