SUBJECT: NORTHEAST OHIO FLOOD 2003 - ADDITIONAL COUNTY ADDED

We recently announced the availability of GRF funds for disaster assistance for elderly and disabled individuals who have been adversely affected by the recent severe weather conditions and a cap of \$200, 000 per county for families who could qualify for PRC-related disaster assistance. Please refer to Office of Family Stability Letter (OFSL) #10, dated July 28, 2003.

Since the issuance of the letter, the Governor has declared Stark County to be in a state of emergency as a result of the recent weather emergency. This brings the total number of counties to seven. The counties affected are Cuyahoga, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Stark, Summit, and Trumbull. Other counties may be added at a later date, if or when declared by the Governor to be in a state of emergency.

Please reference the Office of Family Stability Letter #10 for eligibility requirements, the maximum amount of funds that will be available to each county and the funding and fiscal coding procedures.
