## Program Year 2024 UNADJUSTED Annual

The WIOA Title I Performance Report is produced by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services' Office of Workforce Development for distribution to Local Workforce Area directors, Workforce Development professionals, and WIOA performance contacts and stakeholders. The report contains participant and program data for Program Year 2024 (PY 2024) from Advancement through Resources Information & Employment Services (ARIES). PY 2024 runs from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

The report is organized by statewide and by WIOA Local Workforce Area. Each section contains summary performance data and participant demographic data. Additional information and definitions of performance measures, their evaluation, and performance cohorts are in the beginning of this document for reference. A glossary of terms used throughout the report is at the end of this document.

**NOTE: For the PY 2024 Adjusted Annual Report, the negotiated standard will be adjusted according to the Statistical Adjustment Model, which accounts for changes in the characteristics of the participants served and economic factors in each WIOA Local Workforce Area. This "UNADJUSTED" Quarterly Report includes the numerator, denominator, and outcome for each measure for PY 2024 and contains "TBD" ("To Be Determined") for the columns titled "Adjusted Area Standard" and "Area Results". The "ADJUSTED" Annual Report will be released after PY 2024 and will include the final numerator, denominator, outcome AND the "Adjusted Area Standard" AND the evaluation (i.e., success or fails) for "Area Results" for all performance measures (TEN 01-25).**

## WIOA Primary Performance Measures

*For all WIOA Core programs: Adult, Dislocated Worker, Youth, Adult Education and Literacy (ASPIRE), Vocational Rehabilitation and Wagner-Peyser (Wagner-Peyser will be excluded from performance measures 4 and 5):*

**1) Employment 2nd quarter after exit:** The percentage of program participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the second quarter after exit from the program.

**For CCMEP WIOA Youth: Education, training, or employment 2nd quarter after exit:** The percentage of program participants who are in education or training activities, or in unsubsidized employment, during the second quarter after exit from the program.

**2) Employment 4th quarter after exit:** The percentage of program participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the fourth quarter after exit from the program.

**For CCMEP WIOA Youth: Education, training, or employment 4th quarter after exit:** The percentage of program participants who are in education or training activities, or in unsubsidized employment, during the fourth quarter after exit from the program.

## WIOA Primary Performance Measures (continued)

**3) Median earnings 2nd quarter after exit:** The median earnings of program participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the second quarter after exit from the program.

**4) Credential attainment rate:** The percentage of program participants who obtain a recognized postsecondary credential or a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent during participation in or within 1 year after exit from the program. Program participants who obtain a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent shall be included in the percentage counted as meeting the criterion if such participants, in addition to obtaining such diploma or its recognized equivalent, have obtained or retained employment or are in an education or training program leading to a recognized postsecondary credential within 1 year after exit from the program.

**5) Measurable skill gains:** The percentage of program participants who, during a program year, are in an education or training program that leads to a High School Diploma or its Equivalency, a recognized postsecondary credential or employment and who are achieving documented academic, technical, occupational, or other forms of progress, towards such a credential or employment. Gains will be based on attainment of one of the following: 1) gain in at least one educational functioning level; 2) High School Diploma or its Equivalency; 3) secondary/post-secondary transcript/report card showing that the participant is achieving the state unit's policies for academic standards; 4) satisfactory or better progress report towards established milestones from the employer/training provider who is providing training; or 5) successful completion of an exam that is required for a particular occupation, or progress in attaining technical or occupational skills as evidenced by trade-related benchmarks such as knowledge-based exams.

# WIOA Methodology for Assessing Performance as detailed in Ohio Combined State Plan

Under WIOA, official performance evaluation only occurs annually. After the end of the program year, an adjustment of an area's performance standard(s) may occur as a result of updated demographic and economic indicators by means of the Statistical Adjustment Model. Only after this adjustment process is complete can an official evaluation of an area's performance be accomplished (TEGL 9-17).

Performance on an individual measure will be interpreted based on the position of the outcome relative to the local area performance standard using the criteria defined below. Achieving a '**Success**' on all individual measures indicates that a local workforce area performed successfully. Obtaining a '**Fails**' on any individual measure constitutes local workforce area failure.

**Success:** When the actual local area performance achieved against an individual performance measure falls in the range of 90 percent or greater of the performance standard for the measure

**Fails:** When the actual local area performance achieved against an individual performance measure is less than 90 percent of the performance standard

## Adult Performance Measures Area Comparison Charts



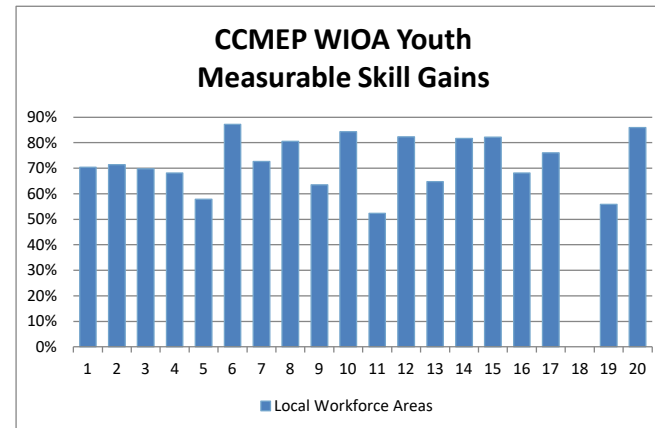
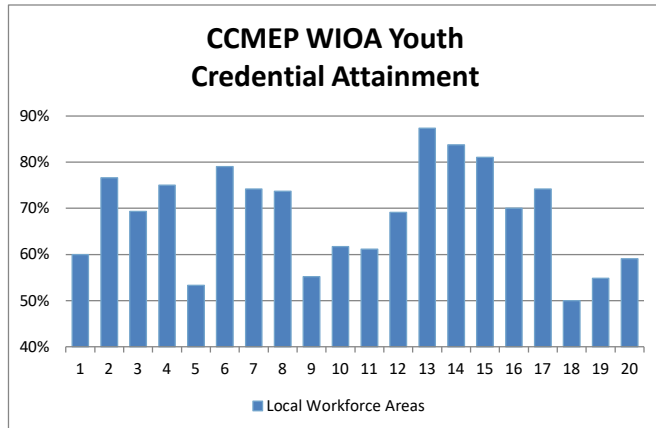
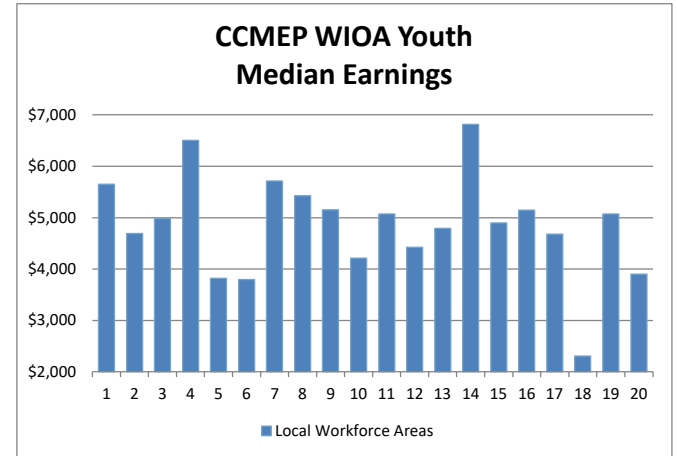
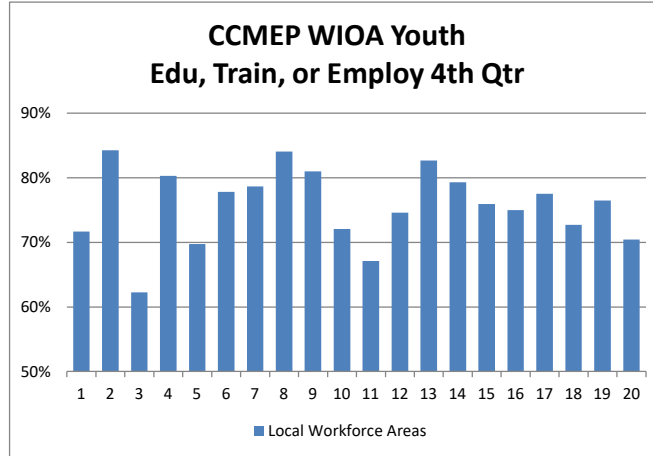
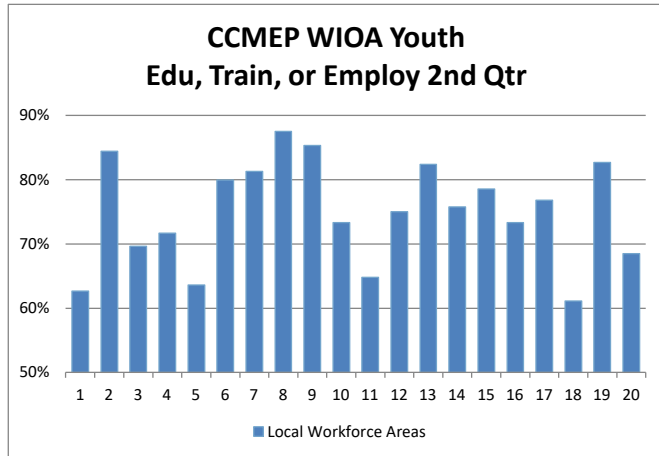

**Adult:** A participant in the WIOA Adult program must meet all the following requirements: (1) Be legally authorized to work in the United States; (2) Be 18 years of age or older; and (3) Be properly registered for selective service (WIOAPL No. 15-02.1).

**Area Rate:** The actual level of performance achieved in the WIOA Local Area. It is the Area numerator (see “Numerator”) divided by the Area denominator (see “Denominator”) expressed as a percentage. The rate of median earnings is the exception; the median represents the mid-point between the value of the lowest wage reported and the value of the highest wage reported of the performance measure cohort.

**Area Standard:** The local area negotiated level of performance. Local areas negotiate with the State of Ohio every two years to decide local area performance standards/goals for each performance measure.

**Baseline:** A starting point used for comparison. For performance measures without an established standard, data will be collected to establish a baseline, and performance will be evaluated against a standard in future program years.

**Basic Skills Deficient:** A youth who has English reading, writing, or computing skills at or below the 8th grade level, based on a generally accepted standardized test, or who is unable to compute or solve problems, or read, write, or speak English, at a level necessary to function on the job, in the individual’s family, or in society (WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**CCMEP WIOA Youth:** An eligible participant in the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program (CCMEP) WIOA Youth program must be an individual who faces a number of barriers (including, but not limited to, pregnancy/parenting, disability, or homelessness) and either: (a) Is between the ages of 14 and 21, is attending school (see “In-School Youth”), and has low income (see “Low-Income Individuals”); or (b) Is between the ages of 16 and 24 and is not attending school (see “Out-of-School Youth”; WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**Cohort:** A group of participants who are evaluated for performance during the same time period.

**Cohort Period:** The cohort period defines the time frame (in quarters) of participation or program exit that the cohort is being evaluated for the performance measure.

**Credential:** A nationally recognized degree or certificate which is State and locally recognized and indicates possession of some training, knowledge, or skill.

**Credential Attainment Rate:** The percentage of all program participants who attain a credential during participation or within 1 year of exiting the program, out of those enrolled in education or a training program leading to a recognized diploma, degree, or a credential.

**Cultural Barriers:** An individual with a cultural barrier perceives him/herself as possessing attitudes, beliefs, customs, or practices that influence a way of thinking, acting, or working that may serve as a hindrance to employment.

**Denominator:** Count of the total number of eligible participants in a cohort for an individual measure; the bottom number in a ratio. For example, in the fraction 2/5, the number five is the denominator.

**Dislocated Worker:** A participant in the WIOA Dislocated Worker program must meet the requirements for WIOA Adults (see “Adult”) and must also fall into one or more of the following eligibility categories as outlined in section 3(15) (A-E) of WIOA, P.L. 113-128:

- Category A: Terminated or Laid Off, or Received a Notice of Termination or Layoff From Employment: (1) Has been terminated or laid off, or has received a notice of termination or layoff, from employment; and (2)(a) Is eligible for or has exhausted entitlement to unemployment compensation; or (b) Has been employed for a duration sufficient to demonstrate attachment to the workforce, but is not eligible for unemployment compensation due to insufficient

earnings or having performed services for an employer that were not covered under a state unemployment compensation law; and (3) Is unlikely to return to a previous industry or occupation.

- **Category B: Plant Closure or Substantial Layoff:** (a) Has been terminated or laid off, or has received a notice of termination or layoff, from employment as a result of any permanent closure of or any substantial layoff at a plant, facility, or enterprise; (b) Is employed at a facility where the employer has made a general announcement that such facility will close within 180 days; or (c) For purposes of eligibility to receive services under WIOA (P.L. 113-128), other than training services described in section 134(c)(3), career services described in section 134(c)(2)(A)(xii), or supportive services, is employed at a facility at which the employer has made a general announcement that such facility will close.
- **Category C: Self-Employed Individual:** Was self-employed (including employment as a farmer, rancher, or fisherman) but is unemployed as a result of general economic conditions in the community in which the individual resides or because of natural disasters.
- **Category D: Displaced Homemaker:** Is a displaced homemaker (see “Displaced Homemaker”).
- **Category E: Military Spouse:** (a) Is married to a member of the Armed Forces on active duty (as defined in section 101(d)(1) of title 10, United States Code), and who has experienced a loss of employment as a direct result of relocation to accommodate a permanent change in duty station of such member; or (b) Is married to a member of the Armed Forces on active duty and meets the criteria of a displaced homemaker who is unemployed or underemployed and is experiencing difficulty in obtaining or upgrading employment (WIOAPL No. 15-02.1).

**Displaced Homemaker:** An individual who has been providing unpaid services to family members in the home and who: (1)(a) Has been depending on the income of another family member but is no longer supported by that income; or (b) Is the dependent spouse of a member of the Armed Forces on active duty (as defined in Section 101(d)(1) of title 10, United States Code) and whose family income is significantly reduced

because of a deployment (as defined in section 991(b) of title 10, United States Code, or pursuant to paragraph (4) of such section); a call or order to active duty pursuant to a provision of law preferred to in section 101(a)(13)(B) of title 10, United States Code; a permanent change of station; or the service-connected (as defined in section 101(16) of title 38, United States Code) death or disability of the member; and (2) Is unemployed or underemployed and is experiencing difficulty in obtaining or upgrading employment (TEGL 19-16).

**Educational Level:** The highest degree attained by the participant at the time of program enrollment.

**Education Status:** A youth participant's school status at the time of program enrollment. The youth is either attending school (i.e., “In-School”) or not attending any school (i.e., “Out-of-School”).

**Education, Training, or Employment 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter After Exit:** The percentage of Youth program participants in education, training, or unsubsidized employment (see “Unsubsidized Employment”) during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter after exit out of all Youth program participants who have exited in the cohort period.

**Education, Training, or Employment 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter After Exit:** The percentage of Youth program participants in education, training, or unsubsidized employment (see “Unsubsidized Employment”) during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter after exit out of all Youth program participants who have exited in the cohort period.

**English Language Learner:** An individual who has limited ability in reading, writing, speaking, or comprehending the English language whose native language is a language other than English or who lives in a family or community environment where English is not the dominant language.

**Employment 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter After Exit:** The percentage of Adult or Dislocated Worker program participants in unsubsidized employment (see “Unsubsidized Employment”) during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter after exit out of all Adult or Dislocated Worker program participants who have exited in the cohort period.

**Employment 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter After Exit:** The percentage of Adult or Dislocated Worker program participants in unsubsidized employment (see “Unsubsidized Employment”) during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter after exit out of all Adult or Dislocated Worker program participants who have exited in the cohort period.

**Excluded from Performance Measures:** A participant may be exited from the Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth programs and excluded from performance reporting for the following reason(s): (1) The participant has become incarcerated in a correctional institution or has become a resident of an institution or facility providing 24-hour support (i.e., a hospital or treatment center) during the course of receiving services; (2) The participant exits the program because of medical treatment expected to last longer than 90 days which precludes entry into unsubsidized employment (see “Unsubsidized Employment”) or continued participation in the program; (3) The participant is deceased; (4) The participant is a member of the National Guard or other reserve military unit of the armed forces and is called to active duty for at least 90 days; and (5) For the WIOA Youth program only, the participant is in the foster care system and exits the program because the participant has moved from the local area as part of such a program or system (WIOAPL No. 17-02).

**Exit:** The term “exit” or “program exit” means that a participant has not received a service funded by WIOA or a partner program for 90 consecutive calendar days and is not scheduled for future services, except follow-up services. The exit date represents the last day on which the individual received a service funded by WIOA or a partner program.

**Fails:** The “fail” level represents less than 90% of the performance standard for an individual Adult, Dislocated Worker, or CCMEP WIOA Youth measure. The actual local area performance will be considered a “fail” if the area rate for an individual performance measure is less than 90% of the performance standard for the measure.

**Homeless Individual / Runaway Youth:** An individual who lacks fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence including: (1) An individual (including children and youth) who: (a) Is sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; (b) Is living in a motel, hotel, trailer park, or campground due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations; (c) Is living in an emergency or transitional shelter; (d) Is abandoned in a hospital; or (e) Is awaiting foster care placement; (2) An individual (including children and youth) who has a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; (3) Children and youth who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings; and (4) Migratory children (as defined in 20 U.S.C. 6399) who qualify as homeless because the children are living in one of the previously mentioned circumstances listed above (WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**Individual with a Disability:** Any person who: (a) Has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities of such individual; (b) Has a record of such impairment; or (c) Is regarded as having such an impairment (WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**In-School Youth:** An individual, who at the time of enrollment, is: (1) Attending school, including secondary and postsecondary school; (2) Not younger than 14 or older than age 21 (unless an individual with a disability who is attending school under state law); (3) A low-income individual (see “Low-Income Individuals”); and (4) Has one or more of the following barriers: (a) Basic skills deficient (see “Basic Skills Deficient”); (b) An English language learner (see “English Language Learner”); (c) An offender (see “Offender”); (d) A homeless individual, homeless child or youth, or a

runaway (see “Homeless Individuals / Runaway Youth”); (e) An individual in foster care or has aged out of the foster care system or has attained 16 years of age and left foster care for kinship guardianship or adoption, a child eligible for assistance under the John H. Chafee Foster Care Independence Program, or in an out-of-home placement; (f) An individual who is pregnant or parenting (custodial or non-custodial); (g) An individual with a disability (see “Individual with a Disability”); or (h) An individual who requires additional assistance to complete an education program or to secure or hold employment (WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**Lacks Transportation:** An individual who has no affordable or reliable means of travel to commute to childcare, education, training, or employment that is located beyond a reasonable distance to walk or ride a bicycle. This includes individuals without reliable access to:

- A privately-owned vehicle;
- A public transit system;
- A public transit/human services solution per the county’s coordinated transportation plan (available at <https://www.transportation.ohio.gov/programs/transit/transit-coordination-resources/list-coordinated-plans>); or
- Regular car-pooling or ride-sharing options.

**Long-Term Unemployed:** An individual who has been unemployed for 27 or more consecutive weeks (WIOAPL No. 15-08.1).

**Low-Income Individual:** An individual who: (1) Receives, or in the past 6 months has received, or is a member of a family that is receiving or in the past 6 months has received, assistance through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), the Supplemental Security Income (SSI), or State or local income-based public assistance; (2) Is in a family with a total family income that does not exceed the higher of: (a) The poverty line; or (b) 70% of the lower living standard income level; (3) Is a homeless individual, child, or youth; (4) Receives or is eligible to receive a free or reduced price lunch (does not include students in school districts participating in the Community Eligibility

Provision Health, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010); (5) Is a foster child on behalf of whom the State or local government payments are made; or (6) Is an individual with disability whose own income meets the eligibility income requirements of clause (2) but who is a member of a family whose income does not meet this requirement (WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**Low Levels of Literacy:** An individual with low levels of literacy is unable to read, write, or speak English at a level necessary to function on the job, in the individual’s family, or in society.

**Measurable Skill Gains:** The percentage of program participants who, during a program year, are in an education or training program that leads to a High School Diploma or its Equivalency, a recognized postsecondary credential, or employment and who are achieving documented academic, technical, occupational, or other forms of progress towards such a credential or employment. Gains will be based on attainment of one of the following: (a) Gain in at least one educational functioning level; (b) High School Diploma or its Equivalency; (c) Secondary/post-secondary transcript/report card showing that the participant is achieving the state unit’s policies for academic standards; (d) Satisfactory or better progress report towards established milestones from the employer/training provider who is providing training; or (e) Successful completion of an exam that is required for a particular occupation, or progress in attaining technical or occupational skills as evidenced by trade-related benchmarks such as knowledge-based exams. A gain must be attained and documented by the end of each Program Year (i.e., June 30<sup>th</sup>).

**Median Earnings 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter after Exit:** The median earnings of program participants in unsubsidized employment (see “Unsubsidized Employment”) in the 2nd quarter after exit. The median represents the mid-point between the value of the lowest wage reported and the value of the highest wage reported during the cohort period. Employment and earnings will be verified via wage record data from several different sources.

**Migrant and Seasonal Farmworker:** An individual who is employed, or was employed in the past 12 months, in farm work of a seasonal or temporary nature, including those whose agricultural labor requires travel to a job site such that they are unable to return to a permanent place of residence within the same day.

**Numerator:** Count of successful outcomes for an individual measure; the top number in a ratio. For example, in the fraction 2/5, the number two is the numerator.

**Offender:** An adult or youth who: (a) Is or has been subject to any stage of the criminal justice process, and for whom services under WIOA may be beneficial; or (b) Requires assistance in overcoming artificial barriers to employment resulting from a record of arrest or conviction (WIOAPL No. 15-20.2).

**Older Individuals:** Individuals aged 55 years or older.

**Out-of-School Youth:** A individual, who at the time of enrollment, is:  
(1) Not attending any school; (2) Not younger than 16 or older than age 24; and (3) Has one or more of the following barriers: (a) A school dropout; (b) A youth who is within the age of compulsory school attendance, but has not attended school for at least the most recent complete school year calendar quarter; (c) A recipient of a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent who is a low-income individual (see “Low-Income Individuals”) and is basic skills deficient (see “Basic Skills Deficient”) or an English language learner (see “English Language Learner”); (d) An offender (see “Offender”); (e) A homeless individual, homeless child or youth, or a runaway (see “Homeless “); (f) An individual in foster care or has aged out of the foster care system or has attained 16 years of age and left foster care for kinship guardianship or adoption, a child eligible for assistance under the John H. Chafee Foster Care Independence Program, or an individual in an out-of-home placement; (g) An individual who is pregnant or parenting (custodial or non-custodial); (h) A youth who is an individual with a disability (see “Individual with a Disability”); or (i) A low-income individual who

requires additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure or hold employment (WIOAPL No. 15-03.1).

**Participant:** An individual who has been determined to be eligible to participate in and who is receiving services, except follow-up services, authorized under WIOA. Participation shall be deemed to commence on the first day on which the individual began receiving either a youth program element, a career service triggering participation, or a training service.

**Program Year (PY):** A program year begins on July 1st and ends on June 30th of the following year. For example, PY 2022 begins on July 1st, 2022 and ends on June 30th, 2023.

**Single Parent:** A single, separated, divorced, or widowed individual who: (a) Has primary responsibility for one or more dependent children under age 18 or a dependent with a disability; or (b) Is currently pregnant.

**Statewide Rate:** The actual level of performance achieved statewide. It is the statewide numerator divided by the statewide denominator expressed as a percentage. The rate of median earnings is the exception; the median represents the mid-point between the value of the lowest wage reported and the value of the highest wage reported of the performance measure cohort.

**Success:** The “success” level represents 90% of the performance standard for an individual Adult, Dislocated Worker, or CCMEP WIOA Youth measure. The actual local area performance will be considered a “success” if the area rate for an individual performance measure is 90% or greater of the performance standard for the measure.

**Unsubsidized Employment:** Employment in the private sector or public sector for which the employer does not receive a subsidy from public funds to offset all or a part of the wages and costs of employing an individual.

**Veteran:** Any person who served at least one day in the active military, naval, or air service, and who was discharged or released under conditions other than “dishonorable.” Active service includes full-time Federal service in the National Guard or a Reserve component, other than full-time duty for training purposes (WIOAPL No. 15-20.2).

**Youth in Foster Care or Aged Out of System:** An individual who: (a) Is in the foster care system; (b) Has aged out of the foster care system; (c) Has attained age 16 and left foster care for kinship guardianship or adoption; (d) Is a child eligible for assistance under the John H. Chafee Foster Care Independence Program; or (e) Is in an out-of-home placement.
