**NOTICE OF PLANT CLOSURE**

**Dear Administrator Tarr and Mayor Woods,**

This letter is being issued in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (“WARN”) Act. Circumstances will force Stingray Pressure Pumping (the “Company”) to conduct layoffs, engage in the sale of the Company’s assets, and close entirely its Ohio plant. The Company’s plant subject to closure is located at 42739 National Road, Belmont, Ohio, 43718. The plant has ceased most operations and anticipates that no operations will be conducted at the facility after August 15, 2025. We expect the closure of the plant to be permanent.

The closure of the plant will result in the termination of the employment of 75 full-time employees effective August 15, 2025.. The job titles of those full-time employees and the number of employees in each position, are as follows:
