Dear Ms. Tarr:

Due to changing market conditions, TOPS Products, LLC has decided to permanently close our facility located at 851 Smead Rd, Logan, OH 43138. Consistent with these plans, employment separations are expected to commence starting December 1, 2025. The closure will be permanent, and all employees involved in office supply manufacturing work, approximately 207 people, will be affected.

We are committed to making the transition as smooth as possible for our employees, our customers and for the community. At this time, the Company anticipates that all employees will be permanently separated from employment with the Company, during the time period between December 1, 2025 and April 2, 2027. A list of job titles and the number of employees currently holding affected positions accompanies this letter as Exhibit A. At this time, all affected employees are non-union. In connection with the plant closure, no employees will have bumping rights to displace other employees working for the Company.

This announcement and the above timetable are based on the best information currently available. However, various factors may still affect the timing of any employment separations. You will be informed of any significant changes in these plans, as additional information becomes available.

To the extent that this action constitutes a covered event under the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN) and any corresponding state or local law, this letter is intended to fulfill any legal notice requirements.
