Due to changes in our network, UPS employees assigned to the Middleburg day sort at 17940 Englewood Dr, Middleburg Heights, Ohio 44130 will be separated from employment beginning July 1, 2025, unless otherwise required by the applicable collective bargaining agreement. UPS remains in the above-referenced facility, but this sort closure is expected to be permanent.

There are 98 part-time hourly employees who are expected to be impacted by this sort closure. UPS will attempt to mitigate the impacts by offering work to affected employees in other positions where possible.

This closure will affect union employees. Union employees are represented by the International Brotherhood of Teamsters. There are bumping rights in effect for union employees for this reduction in force.
