On behalf of Republic National Distributing Company, LLC (the “Company”), this letter provides an extension notice pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 et seq., as amended, Ohio Revised Code § 4113.31, and any similar applicable state or local laws (collectively, the “WARN Act”). If this extension notice is not legally required, the Company is providing this extension notice to you voluntarily.

Reference is hereby made to that certain WARN Act extension notice you were provided on July 31, 2026 (the “First Extension Notice”). The Company’s operations located at 125 E. Court St., Suite 210 Downtown, Cincinnati, OH, 45242 (the “Cincinnati Facility”), 5747 Westbourne Ave, Columbus, OH, 43213 (the “Columbus Facility”) and 4460 Lake Forest Drive, Suite 238, Cincinnati, OH, 45242 (the “Remote Facility”) (collectively, the “Facilities”) are expected to be purchased by a third-party (the “Transaction”). As outlined in the First Extension Notice, as a result of the Transaction, employees employed at or reporting to the Facilities were expected to terminate on or within fourteen (14) days after August 31, 2026. The Company is providing this extension notice to you because the expected closing date of the Transaction has been delayed, and the termination date of employees employed at or reporting to the Facilities is accordingly being postponed. The contemplated purchaser or its affiliate has extended, and may further extend, offers of employment to certain of the Company’s employees at or reporting to the Facilities. In addition, certain corporate and other employees may continue to be employed by the Company, including to provide transition services. However, we are providing this extension notice to you at this time since there is no guarantee that the pending Transaction will close, and it is not yet known who will be needed to continue employment with the Company.

As a result of the contemplated Transaction, the Company and its affiliates currently expect to cease their operations of the Facilities. Accordingly, the Company or its affiliates expect to terminate the employment of employees employed at or reporting to the Facilities on the closing date of the Transaction, which is expected to be September 29, 2026, or within fourteen (14) days thereafter (such date, the “Separation Date”). There are a total of 4 affected employees at the Cincinnati Facility, and 3 remote employees reporting to the Remote Facility. All such employees or, as applicable, the unions that represent them, have been provided further WARN Act extension notices. As the Company and its affiliates expect to be ceasing operations at the Facilities, all such terminations of employment with the Company will be permanent, and affected employees will not have bumping rights for other positions with the Company or its affiliates.
