To Whom It May Concern:

On April 18, 2023 you were provided notification of layoff effective June 18, 2023. Crothall Management has been advised that the transition date has been extended to August 20, 2023.

This letter will serve as official notice under the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Act, that a layoff impacting the hourly and salaried Environmental Services and Patient Transportation Crothall Healthcare employees will occur at the following St. Elizabeth Boardman Hospital location in Mahoning County on August 20th, 2023.

- Youngstown

This will impact 88 employees. Notices to these impacted employees were issued by hand and mail as of June 7, 2023.

We expect this action will be permanent, and we reasonably anticipate that some employees will be hired by the hospital. The impacted workers are not represented by any labor organization or union therefore no bumping rights exist.
