- Meet the financial criteria for Medicaid eligibility determined by your [Local Agencies Directory | Job and Family Services](#).
- Meet a nursing facility level of care.
- Be at age 60 or older.

The Ohio Department of Medicaid is the administrative agency for this waiver program. The Ohio Department of Aging is the operating agency. PASSPORT Administrative Agencies provide case management as an administrative function.
