

MyCare Ohio waiver programs

Members coming into MyCare Ohio may receive services at home or in a home-like setting through the Ohio Home Care, PASSPORT, or Assisted Living waivers.

How do I know if I am eligible for a MyCare Ohio waiver?

To be eligible for the MyCare Ohio waiver, you must:

1. Be enrolled in a MyCare Ohio program at time of waiver application.
 2. Be determined to meet a nursing facility-based level of care.
 3. Require hospitalization or nursing facility services to meet needs in the absence of the waiver.
 4. Require at least one waiver service per month, **OR**
 - a. Require at least one waiver service per year, and;
 - b. Meet with your care coordinator monthly.
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What waiver programs are available?

Ohio Home Care waiver: Allows individuals with physical disabilities and unstable medical conditions to receive care in their homes and communities instead of nursing facilities, hospitals, or rehabilitation facilities.

Ohio Assisted Living waiver: Pays the costs of care in an assisted living facility for eligible Medicaid members, allowing them to use their personal resources to cover "room and board" expenses.

Ohio PASSPORT/Choices waiver: Helps Medicaid-eligible Ohioans get the long-term services and supports they need to stay in their homes or other community settings, rather than enter nursing homes.
