

How Do Providers Submit Claims in the Next Generation MyCare Program?



In the **Next Generation MyCare program**, claims can be submitted in the following ways.

OPTION 1: Direct Data Entry (DDE)

Submit claims within the plan's portal. Visit the plan DDE portals to learn how to enroll and submit claims.

OPTION 2: Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

Submit EDI claims typically via a trading partner. The process for submitting claims differs based on who the primary payer is.

Initial Submission Through the Ohio Medicaid Enterprise System (OMES) One Front Door For Medicaid primary claims for a Medicaid-only or dual benefit MyCare member

Submit through the OMES One Front Door. Use the member's Medicaid ID, plan Receiver ID, and the appropriate Payer ID in the 2010BB loop.

Initial Submission Through Medicare

For Medicare primary claims for a Medicaid-only MyCare member

Submit using the normal process. Cross-over occurs automatically when the member has original Medicare.

For Medicare Advantage/Part C primary claims for a Medicaid-only MyCare member

Submit to the Medicare plan using the normal process. Then submit through the OMES One Front Door using the member's Medicaid ID, plan Receiver ID, and the appropriate Payer ID.

New to Billing?

Already bill services for Managed Care? Consider using the same process for Next Generation MyCare. If you use a trading partner, contact them before the program starts to confirm any extra steps needed.

Don't have an existing process? Consider which option is best for you.

- 1 Smaller claim volume: Consider using DDE.
- 2 Larger claim volume: Consider contracting with a trading partner. View [ODM's Electronic Data Interchange \(EDI\) Authorized Trading Partners list](#) and contact a few to find the one the best fit for your needs.
