CPC 2023 Program Year Welcome

CPC Program Overview

- □Team-based delivery model led by a primary care practice that manages a patient's healthcare needs
- □Goal is to deliver the best care while improving quality and lowering costs
- □The program coincides with each calendar year
 - □ Program Year 2023 runs 1/1/2023 to 12/31/2023
- □ Program regulations are in the following Ohio Administrative Code rules:
 - □5160-19-01 at https://codes.ohio.gov/ohio-administrative-code/rule-5160-19-01
 - □5160-19-02 at https://codes.ohio.gov/ohio-administrative-code/rule-5160-19-02

CPC Program Overview Continued

- □The following are member exclusions from payment:
 - □ Individuals with both Medicaid and Medicare coverage
 - □Individuals with limited Medicaid benefits
 - □ Individuals with third party liability insurance
 - □ Individuals in the Comprehensive Maternal Care (CMC) or OhioRISE programs

CPC Activity Requirements

- □24/7 and same-day access to care
- □Risk stratification
- □Population health management
- □Team-based care delivery
- □Follow-up after hospital discharge
- □Tests and specialist referrals
- □Patient experience
- □Community services and supports integration
- ■Behavioral health integration
- Care coordination

Clinical Quality and Efficiency Metrics

- □Clinical Quality Metrics
 - □Aligned with ODM's population health strategy
- □ Efficiency Metrics
 - ■ED visit rate
 - □Inpatient admission rate for ambulatory sensitive conditions
 - ■Behavioral health related inpatient admission rate
 - □Adherence to preferred drug list
- □ Practices must pass 50% of both quality and efficiency metrics to remain in good standing in the program

CPC for Kids

- □Focuses on attributed pediatric Medicaid covered individuals under twenty-one years of age
- Optional enhancement for eligible CPC entities
- ☐ To be eligible, a CPC entity must:
 - □ Participate in the CPC program for the same performance period
 - □ Have at least 150 attributed pediatric Medicaid individuals
- □Administered at the entity level (e.g., quality metrics, performance on bonus activities)

CPC for Kids Quality Metrics Linked to Payment Streams

Well-Child Visits in First 15 Months of Life Well-Child visits for members who are 3 – 11 years of age Adolescent Well-Care Visit for members who are 12 - 17 years of Current Ohio CPC age pediatric metrics Weight assessment and counseling for nutrition and physical activity for children/adolescents: BMI assessment for Must pass 50% children/adolescents of applicable metrics Must pass Lead screening (one or more at 2 years of age) Additional CPC for at least one Immunization for children (HEDIS combination 3)1 **Kids metrics** applicable linked to payment Immunization for adolescents (HEDIS combination 2)1 metric Additional CPC for Tobacco cessation for ages 12-17 Kids metrics Fluoride varnish





Contains attributed members and associated PMPM payments for each quarter


Includes adult and pediatric attributed members

- Your PNM Administrator can access your CPC Reports by clicking "Menu" on the top left side of the home screen then clicking "Payment Innovation Reports" in the menu drop down
- Agents must be assigned the "Provider Payment Innovation Reports Agent" role for the Med ID that is being issued reports



Reporting Changes



OAC 5160-1-17.2 Provider agreement for providers

- States that <u>ODM</u> is to be informed within thirty days of any changes this includes but is not limited to licensure, certification, registration status, ownership, specialty and addresses where services are rendered
- It is the responsibility of the PNM Administrator to keep all the information including demographics and CPC contact information in the PNM system up-todate



- ■Next Generation of managed care organizations will launch on February 1, 2023
- □Implementation of the new Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) will increase transparency and visibility of member care and services
- □OMES modules will be launched to provide streamlined processes for claims, prior authorizations, and other administrative tasks for provider
