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## Medicaid Buy-In for Workers with Disabilities and Ohio WorkAbility

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Through the Medicaid Buy-In for Workers with Disabilities (MBIWD) and Ohio WorkAbility programs, Ohioans with disabilities are able to work and still keep their health care coverage.

You may be eligible for the program if you are:

- a U.S. citizen or meet qualified non-citizen requirements
- a resident of Ohio
- 16 years or older,
- living with a disability as defined by the Social Security Administration (SSA),
- employed in paid full or part time work, and
- within the financial guidelines of the program.
