Pregnancy Related Services

Ohio Medicaid provides pregnancy related services to support healthy moms and healthy babies, in addition to regular prenatal care.

Pregnancy related services can:

- increase a woman's well-being during pregnancy,
- help prevent complications and minimize discomfort, and
- help identify danger signals for early labor or miscarriage.

Services available to pregnant women include:

- assistance with scheduling medical appointments,
- transportation to Medicaid-covered services,
- referral to the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) program,
 which provides healthy food and information on healthy eating,
- referral to the *Help Me Grow* program,
- services available to your family through Healthchek
- education about how to take care of your baby, and
- referrals to community services for food, clothing and other needs.
