OCJS AND THE BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM

The Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services ([OCJS](#)) is a division of the Ohio Department of Public Safety. By statute, OCJS is the lead justice planning and assistance office for the state, administering millions of dollars in state and federal criminal justice funding every year. OCJS also evaluates programs and develops technology, training, and products for criminal justice professionals and communities. Governor Mike DeWine has designated OCJS to administer the 2023 Ohio Body-worn Camera Grant Program (“BWC Grant Program”).

Law enforcement agencies are increasingly using body-worn cameras to serve a multitude of functions: to improve evidence collection, to train officers, to strengthen officer performance and accountability, to enhance agency transparency, and to document and investigate encounters between police and the public. In 2021, at the request of Governor Mike DeWine, \$10 million was set aside in the state budget to help outfit law enforcement officers across the state with body cameras, in an effort to achieve Governor DeWine’s goal “that most, if not all, law enforcement agencies in the state will establish a body camera program with the help of this grant funding.” ([Governor DeWine press release](#), Feb 3, 2021).

WHAT TO EXPECT

Application. Match is **not** a requirement for this grant and should not be included in the budget. Agencies may submit only one application per subrecipient.

Funding Amount. There is no funding cap; however, funding is limited. While grant funds can be used for various expenses related to implementing an agency’s body worn camera program, funds will be prioritized for agencies that do not currently have a body camera program.

Average Award Amount. The average award amount for FY2024 was \$43,482.13 (ranging from \$3,656.56 - \$244,838.96).

Review. OCJS staff will review grant proposals using an established process discussed in the “Proposal Narrative” section below. Reviewers assure that project budget costs are allowable and directly relate to the program. OCJS conducts internal compliance reviews of funded projects, assessing the timeliness and thoroughness of their financial and programmatic reporting. The OCJS Executive Director makes final funding recommendations and the Director of the Ohio Department of Public Safety approves them.

Award Notification. Projects will be notified and required to complete all forms and pre-award conditions electronically through the [Online Grants Management System](#). Subrecipients must complete all forms before final approval can be made. Law enforcement agencies **MUST** be

certified on the Body-Worn Camera standard developed through the Ohio Collaborative on Community-Police Relations.

Length of Funding. All awards will be for 24 months of funding, operating from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026. All costs must be incurred during the funding period.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Local law enforcement agencies are eligible to apply as the implementing agency. The unit of local government must serve as the official subrecipient (e.g., township/village/city/county). Funds are not able to be used to support Corrections.

BIDDERS TRAINING

A Bidders Training webinar for the 2025 Body Worn Camera Grant program will take place **October 23, 2024, from 10 am to 11:30 am**. The training will provide information helpful for both the application preparation and review process. PROGRAM PURPOSE

Law enforcement agencies must use BWC Grant Program funds **to support the creation of an agency BWC program or to expand/update an agency's existing BWC program**. Priority will be given to outfitting officers *who regularly interact with the public* that do not currently have functional cameras.

Grant funds can be used to purchase the following:

- Body cameras (dashboard cameras are excluded), related hardware and software for officers who regularly interact with the public, and shipping costs.
- Video storage mechanisms (Examples: server, cloud service)
- Redacting software/service
- Editing/tagging software
- Service agreements for months **July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026**.
- IT costs to support the program
- Maintenance and support fees
- Contract/consultant for programming/installation, training, technical assistance and storage set up
- Personnel costs:
 - Positions must be new. OCJS will not pay for existing position(s)
 - Related to program administration, including but not limited to purchase, installation, training, policy development
 - Related to video support, including but not limited to reviewing/redacting video footage, storing/copying video footage
 - Related to responding to FOIA requests
- Other body-worn camera related expenses not identified above must be justified.

OCJS encourages agencies to have an implementation plan for the body worn camera program. For technical assistance in developing a plan or reviewing a plan please contact OCJS.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE BWC GRANT PROGRAM

Law enforcement agencies applying under this solicitation should be in compliance with crime statistics reporting, using either the Ohio Incident-Based Reporting System or the FBI's NIBRS Collection Application (NCA), per Ohio Revised Code Section 5502.62(C)(6), or if not in compliance must commit to exploring the opportunity to become OIBRS Compliant by including a note in your grant application indicating your commitment to explore.

Additionally, in order to receive BWC Grant Program funds, law enforcement agencies **must**:

- Be certified on the Body-Worn Camera standard developed through the Ohio Collaborative Community-Police Advisory Board at the time of application submission. Appendix A is the current list of agencies certified through the Ohio Collaborative. If you do not see your agency listed, please reach out Carley Auddino-Polko at cmauddino@dps.ohio.gov.
- Discuss in the Narrative how the agency works/will work with allied criminal justice agencies and the community in developing/implementing the agency's BWC program.
- Describe in the Narrative a sustainability plan that describes how the agency plans to financially support a BWC program beyond the life of this grant.
- Describe in the Narrative the required officer and supervisor training on BWC policy and use.
- Provide a breakdown of the annual contract costs in the budget.
- Provide justification for the number of cameras or other equipment requested. Explain each item requested and it's need as it relates to the program. Model numbers are insufficient to describe an items purpose.

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS

All subrecipients are bound by the [Standard Federal Subgrant Conditions | Office of Criminal Justice Services \(ohio.gov\)](#). Please note: the Body Worn Camera Grant is a reimbursement grant. Projects will submit Quarterly Subgrant Reports through the online grants management system to request reimbursement for grant expenses. Reimbursements are contingent on meeting the requirements of the grant including but not limited to performance reporting requirements as described in the Pre-Award Conditions.

1. Fiscal Requirements

- a. OCJS is committed to ensuring grant payments to Subgrantees in the most cost-effective and efficient manner possible. To enhance existing accounts receivable procedures, OCJS will begin requiring all Subgrantees receiving State of Ohio payments via paper check, to enroll in Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). For organizations with multiple physical address codes, specific EFT locations (accounts) may be connected to each address code. Instructions for EFT enrollment are available on the OCJS website <https://ocjs.ohio.gov/grants-funding-monitoring/grants-monitoring-fiscal-compliance/compliance-tools/electronic-funds-transfer-instructions>.
- b. External Audit or Financial Report. Applicants are required to upload a copy of the organization's most recent external audit or most recent financial report to the Collaboration Board Upload section of the application. This allows OCJS to ensure requirements are met for 2 C.F.R. § 200.331(f). Single Audit Act Amendment of 1996, and the OMB Circular A-133. The external audit or most recent financial report should be dated within the past 24 months.
- c. General Ledger. Applicants are required to confirm the ongoing active use of a general ledger defined as a complete record of all the financial transactions over the life of your organization. The general ledger holds all the information needed to prepare financial statements and includes assets, liabilities, equity (net asset), revenue and expenses.
- d. All costs associated listed in the grant budget must be necessary and reasonable for proper and efficient performance and administration of the grant; be consistent with policies, regulations, and procedures that apply uniformly to both Federal and state awards; and be allocable to the grant. A list of unallowable costs can be accessed at [Unallowable Costs | Office of Criminal Justice Services \(ohio.gov\)](#).
- e. Specific cost limits exist for certain allowable costs including:
 - Lodging and meal per diem rates, which cannot exceed the rates set by the federal Government Services Administration (GSA). The rates can be found at [GSA Per Diem Rates](#).
 - Mileage rates, which cannot exceed the rates set by Ohio Budget Management (OBM). These rates can be found at [OBM Travel Rule](#).
 - Laptops, which cannot exceed \$1250.
 - Cell phones, which cannot exceed \$600.
- f. Each application receives a Pre-Risk Assessment to determine risks associated with financial integrity. If an applicant is determined to be moderate, high, or priority high risk, specific conditions of awards may be required as part of the award process.
 - An applicant may be deemed unqualified due to poor performance history

or lack of demonstrated honesty or ethics.

2. **Equal Employment Opportunity.** The Subgrantee shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, disability, age or Vietnam-era status as well as gender identity, provided the subgrantee receives Violence Against Women Act funding. The Subgrantee will ensure applicants are hired and employees are treated fairly during employment without regard to their race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, disability, age or Vietnam-era status as well as gender identity, provided the subgrantee receives Violence Against Women Act funding. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment; upgrading; demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rate of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training including apprenticeship.

The Subgrantee agrees to post in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment, notice setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause. The Subgrantee will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the Subgrantee, State that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, disability, age or Vietnam-era veteran status as well as gender identity, provided the subgrantee receives Violence Against Women Act funding. The Subgrantee shall incorporate the foregoing requirement in all its contracts for any of the work prescribed herein (other than subgrants for standard commercial supplies or raw materials) and will require all of its Subgrantees for any part of such work to incorporate such requirements in all subgrants for such work.

Applicants must submit proposals online through the [Online Grants Management System](#), by 5 p.m. EST on November 20, 2024. *OCJS will not review late applications or consider them for funding.* Failure to follow the specified application requirements will also disqualify applications from review and consideration for funding.

IMPORTANT: Applications must be complete and submitted through the OCJS Grants Management System to be considered for funding. When an application is successfully submitted, the banner at the top of the screen will turn green, and you will receive a confirmation email.
