Project Overview

A. Project Description

The Ohio State University is requesting qualifications from interested Architect/Engineer ("A/E") teams to assist the College of Pharmacy in the development of criteria documents to renovate the existing Pharmacy library space in the Riffe Building to create two 150-seat active learning classrooms, small-group meeting rooms and student seating. The proposed space is comprised of approximately 16,487 square-feet in Riffe with 1,540 square-feet on the first floor and 14,947 square-feet on the second floor.

The renovation project aims to create a modern and flexible learning environment which accommodates active learning pedagogies and fosters collaboration among students, enabling the College to better deliver their PharmD and Undergraduate curriculum. The primary objectives include:

- 1. Creation of Two 150-Seat Active Learning Classrooms:
 - Designing two spacious classrooms equipped with state-of-the-art technology to facilitate active learning methodologies.
 - Ensuring optimal acoustics, lighting, and ergonomic seating arrangements to promote student engagement and comfort.
 - Incorporating flexible furniture and modular designs which allow for easy reconfiguration of the space.
- 2. Small-Group Meeting Rooms:
 - Designing multiple small-group meeting rooms.
 - Creating an atmosphere conducive to focused discussions and collaborative work.
 - Integrating audiovisual capabilities and appropriate furniture to support productive group interactions.
- Student Seating Areas:
 - Establishing comfortable seating arrangements to cater to individual study needs.
 - Incorporating power outlets and connectivity options.
 - Considering aesthetics and ergonomic design principles to create inviting spaces.

The design should build upon already renovated spaces on the first floor of Riffe and in Parks Hall to compliment the established branding to the College of Pharmacy. Criteria A/E is expected to do a furniture layout during design which OSU will use for coordinating with vendor for procurement. This project will provide adequate ADA compliant spaces and shall follow the applicable new sustainability standards found at https://fod.osu.edu/sites/default/files/div_18.pdf. The project will not pursue LEED certification, but the team's experience with LEED registered/certified projects will be scored as comparable experience with the University's sustainable building design standards.

B. Scope of Services

The project delivery method for this project will be Design Build. The project and construction budget as listed in this RFQ is estimated. The selected Criteria Architect/Engineer ("C-A/E") will provide design services which include investigation, design, planning and budgeting. The C-A/E will also assist the University in the review of D/B RFQ/RFP's as well as the selection of the D/B firm. Submittal review will include the C-A/E providing professional opinions to the University such as equipment selection and construction approach.

Pursuant to ORC 153.694, professional design firms selected to provide C-A/E services shall not provide any A/E of Record services for the project for which the professional design firm was selected as the C-A/E.

The project shall follow the applicable University Sustainability Standards. https://fod.osu.edu/sites/default/files/div_18.pdf.

For projects advertised with an appropriately developed Program of Requirements ("POR"), upon award of the Agreement, commence with Design. For projects without such a POR, upon award of the Agreement, commence by developing the Program of Requirements.

The selected Criteria Architect/Engineer ("C-A/E"), as a portion of its required Scope of Services and prior to submitting its proposals, will discuss and clarify with the Owner/Contracting Authority, the cost breakdown of the Architect/Engineer Agreement detailed cost components to address the Owner's project requirements. Participate in the Encouraging Growth, Diversity & Equity ("EDGE") Program as required by statute and the Agreement.

As required by the Agreement, and as properly authorized, provide the following categories of services: Concept and Design Criteria, Best Value Selection, Preconstruction, Construction and Closeout, and Additional Services of all types including Schematic Design and Design Development if a Design-Builder is not engaged to perform these services.

The project team (Owner / C-A/E / DB) will be required to utilize e-Builder, the University's Project Management System, for all compatible services required by the University.

The Ohio State University is dedicated to providing a safe and healthy environment for students, patients, staff, visitors, and contractors. During the construction period, provide not less than 2 hours (excluding travel time) on-site construction administration services each week, including (1) attendance at progress meetings, (2) a written field report of each site visit, (3) on-site representation comprised of the A/E and its consultant staff involved in the primary design of the project, all having relevant and appropriate types of construction administration experience.

For purposes of completing the Relevant Project Experience Matrix in Section F of the Statement of Qualifications (Form F110-330), below is a list of relevant scope of work requirements for this RFQ:

- 1. Experience designing higher education classrooms/meeting spaces.
- 2. Experience with renovation in buildings which must maintain operational functionality.
- 3. Experience with designing building systems on renovation projects including modifications to existing systems.
- 4. Experience with design-build / design-build criteria delivery method.
- 5. Experience on state or university administered projects (preferably with OSU experience)

For the purpose of the selection of 10 Relevant Projects in Section F of the Statement of Qualification (Form F110-330), projects must be designed by the Lead Firm.
