Bidders may submit requests for consideration of a proposed Substitution for a specified product, equipment, or service to the Architect/Engineer (“A/E”) no later than 10 days prior to the bid opening. Additional products, equipment, and services may be accepted as approved Substitutions only by written Addendum.

From time to time, the Commission issues new editions of the “State of Ohio Standard Requirements for Public Facility Construction” and may issue interim changes. Bidders must submit Bids that comply with the version of the Standard Requirements included in the Contract Documents.

Prevailing Wage rates and Equal Employment Opportunity requirements are applicable to this Project.

This Project is subject to the State of Ohio’s Encouraging Diversity, Growth, and Equity (“EDGE”) Business Development Program. A Bidder is required to submit with its Bid and with its Bidder’s Qualifications form, certain information about the EDGE-certified Business(es) participating on the Project with the Bidder. Refer to **Section 6.1.11** of the **Instructions to Bidders**.

The EDGE Participation Goal for the Project is **5 percent**.

The percentage is determined by the contracted value of goods, services, materials, and labor that are provided by EDGE-certified Business(es). The participation is calculated on the total amount of each awarded contract. The Bidder must indicate on the electronic Bid Form, in the spaces provided or by attachment, the locations where its services will be performed, in accordance with the requirements of Executive Order 2019-12D related to providing services only within the United States. The Bidder must also affirm its compliance with Executive Order 2022-02D prohibiting purchases from or investment in any Russian institution or company. Failure to do so may cause the Bid to be rejected as non-responsive.
