2025 HORSE CAMP INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

ALL CAMPSITES ARE RESERVABLE – Camp Host located at site 58

PLEASE FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW TO ENSURE EVERYONE HAS A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE STAY

Check-in / Check-out Times: Check-in time is 3:00 pm. Check-out time is 1:00 pm, at which time all camping equipment and vehicles must be removed from the site.

Registration Age: Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult or furnish a permission slip from parents or guardians with required information.

Maximum Length of Stay: Maximum stay is 14 days within a 30-day period.

Maximum Amount of People Per Site: Six people per site maximum. Events or parties over this limit are prohibited in the campground.

Tent Camping: Up to three tents are permitted per site without a camping vehicle or two tents per site with a camping vehicle. All camping units must be 5' apart and 15' from the road. Please camp only in the designated areas. Do not encroach on adjacent campsites.

Alcohol: Alcohol is permitted at your rented campsite only. All other Ohio Revised Code intoxicating beverage rules apply.

Campsite Parking Per Site: Campsites are permitted to have a maximum of two vehicles as space allows. For safety purposes, all parked vehicles must be kept clear of the roadway.

Quiet Hours: Registered campers are responsible for maintaining quiet hours between 10 pm and 7 am.

Blackwater: Toilet wastewater must be disposed of at the waste dump station, located on Leslie Road.

Pets/Animals: Pets are permitted on all sites. Animals are not permitted in any buildings except for service animals. **PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH in the camp area and on/off trails.** All animals must be under control at all times. Owners should be prepared to show proof of vaccinations. Please be responsible owners and pick up after your animals. Manure, straw, and excess hay must be cleaned up and moved to manure bins, located throughout the camp. Do not leave your animals unattended. Portable corrals are not to be used. Horses and/or picket lines may not be tied to trees, shrubs, or other structures. **Do not run horses in the camping area.**

Collecting: Collecting of plants or the cutting or gathering of trees or dead wood is against the law.

Campfires: Keep all fires contained and do not leave fires unattended. Firewood can be purchased from the park office.

Firearms / Fireworks: Use of firearms is prohibited in the campground. Fireworks are prohibited on state park property.

Trash: Please be kind to your natural resources. Please do not leave trash in the fire pits or on your site. Dumpsters are located near the turn around.
