

CAMPING RULES

PLEASE FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW TO ENSURE EVERYONE HAS A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE STAY

Check-in / check-out times: Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. check-out time is at 1:00 p.m. at which time all camping equipment and vehicles must be removed from the site.

Registration Age: Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult or furnish a permission slip from parents or guardians with required information.

Maximum Length of Stay: Maximum stay is 14 days within a 30-day period. No exceptions.

Maximum Amount of People Per Site: Six people per site maximum.

Tent Camping: Up to three tents are permitted per site without a camping vehicle or two tents per site with a camping vehicle. All camping units must be 5' apart and please camp only in the designated areas, not beyond which may encroach on adjacent campsites. No more than six people permitted per site.

Alcohol: Alcohol is permitted at your rented campsite and cabin site only. All other Ohio Revised Code intoxicating beverage rules apply.

Campsite Parking Per Site: Subject to space availability, two vehicles which includes a tow vehicle for a trailer are allowed per campsite, except that no more than three motorcycles may be parked on the site parking pad in lieu of other vehicles.

- Vehicles must maintain two wheels on the Campsite Pad and must not impede on another site.
- Absolutely no vehicles can be parked on the roadway or obstruct the roadway in any fashion.
- · Visitors and additional vehicles must be parked at the camp store parking lot.
- Shower House Parking restricted to 30 minute time limit with valid pass.
- Violation of this rule may result in issuance of a citation from Law Enforcement. Vehicles are subject to being towed at the owner's expense. OAC 1501:46-13-03 (E), 1501:46-13-04

Visitors / Quiet Hours: Visitors are allowed in the campground until 10 p.m. Visitors may be required to purchase a pass. Registered campers are responsible for maintaining quiet hours between 10p.m. and 7a.m.

Greywater: Dishwater must be disposed of in grey water drains placed throughout the campground or dump station. DO NOT dump it in the grass on your campsite.

Blackwater: Toilet wastewater must be disposed of at the waste dump station near the entrance of the camp store parking lot, on the left-hand side of the road as you enter the parking lot.

Pets: Pets are permitted on all sites. Pets are not permitted in any buildings or shower houses except for service animals. Unless in designated areas, PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH and under control, at all times. Pets cannot be left unattended at any time. Pet owners should be prepared to show proof of vaccinations. Please be responsible pet owners and pick up after your pet.

Collecting: Collecting of plants, or the cutting or gathering of trees or dead wood is against the law. Keep all fires contained to the fire ring.

Firearms / Fireworks: Use of firearms or fireworks is prohibited in the Park.

Trash: Please be kind to your natural resources. Please do not leave trash in the fire rings or on your site. For your convenience, dumpsters are located near the camp store on the right as you exit the campground.
