

Camping Guidelines

LAKE LORAMIE STATE PARK

Please follow the guidelines to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable stay!

Check-in Time: 3:00PM Check-out Time: 1:00PM

Reservations: reserveohio.com All equipment and vehicles must be removed by 1:00pm.

Check-in After Hours: Please set up on a walk-in site if you are checking in after hours, and make arrangements the next day with the camp staff to move to a reserved site. Payment is required before any site is occupied. Self-registration instructions and envelopes are found at the camp office. Please post your receipt from the self-registration envelope on the walk-in site post.

Registration Age: Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult or furnish a permission slip from parents or guardians with required information.

Maximum Stay: 14 days within a 30-day period

Maximum People Per Site: 6 people

Maximum Vehicles Per Site: 2 vehicles as space allows

All parked vehicles must be kept clear of the roadway.

Maximum Tents Per Site: 3 if no camping vehicle

2 with a camping vehicle

All camping units must be 5' apart. Please camp only in designated areas; do not encroach on adjacent campsites. No overnight tents are permitted in the cabin area. Day-use screen tents are permitted. All sites are back-in only camping units with the exception of pull-through sites 91, 151 and 152.

Pets: Pets are permitted on all camping sites (not in Cedar Cabins). Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times. Pets are not permitted in any buildings or shower houses except for service animals. Pet owners should be prepared to show proof of vaccinations. Please be a responsible pet owner and pick up after your pet. Do not leave your pet unattended.

Trash: Please be kind to your natural resources. Do not leave trash in the fire ring or on your site. Dumpsters are located in the maintenance area for your convenience.

Alcohol: Alcohol is permitted at your rented campsite or cabin site only. All other Ohio Revised Code intoxicating beverage rules apply.

Visitors/Quiet Hours: Visitors are allowed in the campground until 10pm. Visitors may be required to purchase a pass. Quiet hours are 10:00pm to 7:00am. Registered campers are responsible for adherence to this rule.

Greywater: Dishwater must be disposed of in wastewater drains or Dump Station near the Campground Check-In Station.

Blackwater: Toilet wastewater must be disposed of at the Dump Station near the Campground Check-In Station.

Collecting: Collecting plants or cutting/gathering trees or dead wood is against the law.

Campfires: Keep all fires contained to the fire ring.

Fireworks and Use of Firearms in the campground are PROHIBITED.
