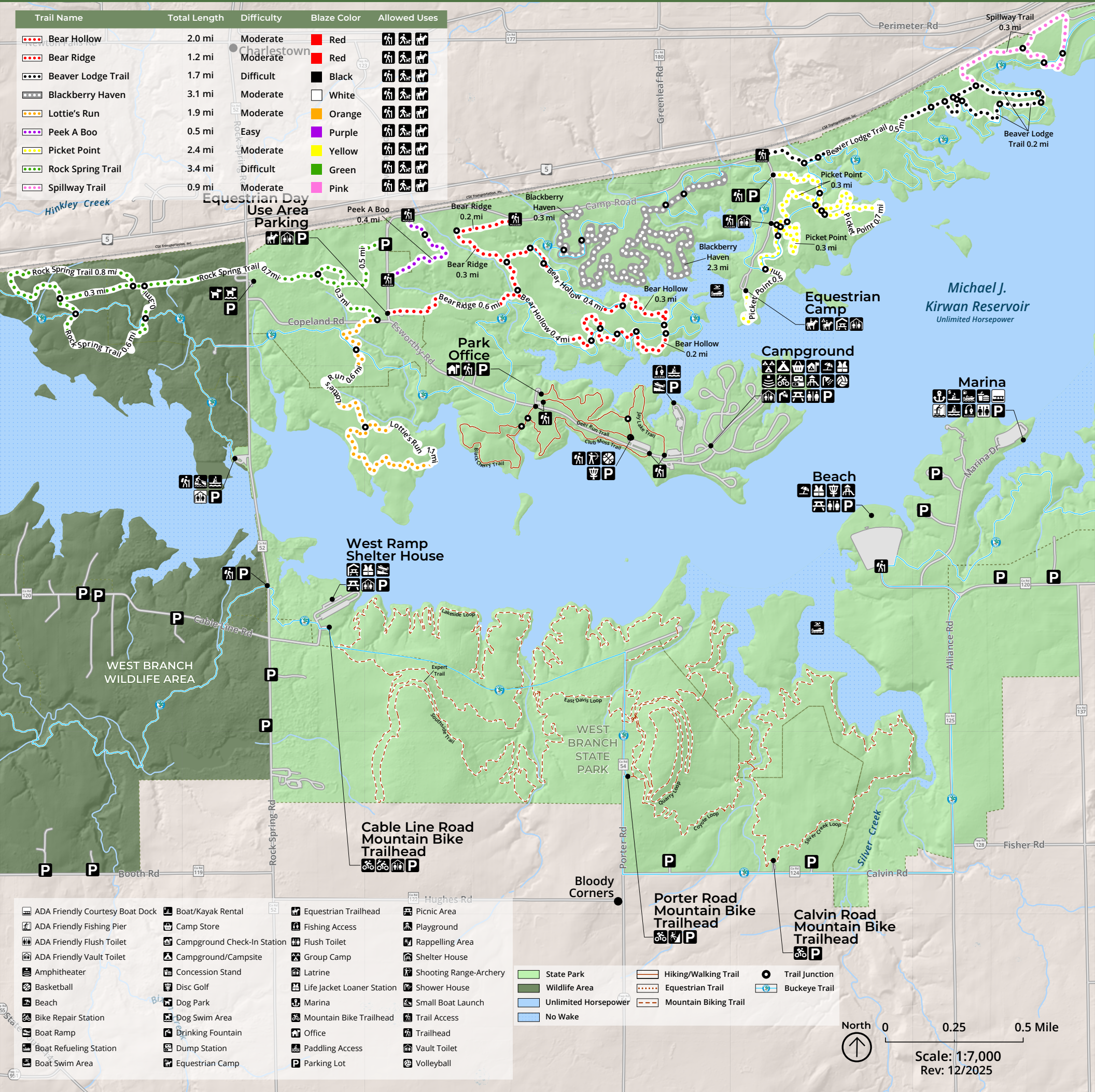

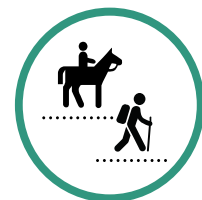
DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES IN THE PARK. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET.
