Cuyahoga	Shaker Heights	Lake-to-Lakes Trail Phase II	\$680,000.00	\$60,000.00	Engineering and construction of a new 10 foot wide asphalt, multi-purpose, ADA-accessible path, approximately 0.6 miles in length, along the north side of Fairhill Road in Shaker Heights and Cleveland Heights. This is Phase II of a larger 5 mile trail construction project that extends across three different cities and will complete the last off-road missing link in a 15-mile system.
Ashtabula	Ashtabula County Metroparks	Ashtabula City North Shore Trail	\$2,154,732.00	\$250,000.00	Construction of 4.2 miles of bike path and bike lanes, which will connect the North Shore Trail to the Great Ohio Lake-to-River Greenway with the Ohio Coastal Trail.
Knox	Knox County Commissioners	Mohican Valley Trail	\$619,726.58	\$446,203.00	Installation of chip/seal asphalt pavement, traffic control, erosion, drainage control, fencing, interpretive signage, and associated design and construction of 9,900 linear feet of the Mohican Valley Trail - Phase I. This project will have future linkages into the Holmes County Trail.
Butler	Hamilton	Great Miami River Recreation Trail	\$1,753,734.00	\$500,000.00	Construction of 1.6 miles of new multi-use trail, which will connect downtown Hamilton and its inner city neighborhoods to Rentschler Forest MetroPark along the Great Miami River. This project also fills an important gap in the 90 mile long Great Miami River Recreational Trail.
Fayette	Fayette County Com/Clinton County PD/Tri-County Commissioners	Clinton Fayette Friendship Trail, Fayette Part I	\$458,588.00	\$247,188.00	Development of 2.2-miles of paved shared-use trail on former utility corridor in two sections. Section I will be from Bush Road NW to Jamison Road. The second section will be from Jasper Road to Cline Road near Washington Courthouse, Ohio.
Delaware	Galena	Galena Brick Trail	\$286,592.00	\$214,944.00	Construction and paving of a 10 feet wide by 2,100 linear feet multi-use asphalt trail, part of the Ohio to Erie Trail. This trail will use road right of way on Dustin Road to connect to the existing Walnut Creek Trail.
Franklin	Gahanna	Big Walnut Trail-Section 5	\$850,000.00	\$400,000.00	Design and construction of 4,500 linear feet by 10 feet wide asphalt multi-use trail. The proposed project will connect to existing phases of the Big Walnut Trail.

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Portage	Village of Hiram	Hiram Extension	\$875,000.00	\$131,250.00	Design, engineering, and development of a 10 foot wide multi-use trail, which will be 5,900 feet in length running from a trailhead on Winrock Road through Hiram College to a second proposed trailhead on Wakefield Road on State Route 305. This is the first phase of a Hiram College connector into the Headwaters Trail.
Clark	Springfield	Little Miami Scenic Trail	\$1,680,903.00	\$450,000.00	The construction of 1.2 miles by 10 foot wide asphalt trail. The proposed project will connect the two missing links for the Little Miami Scenic Trail on the south end of Springfield. The first missing link is between I-70 and John Street and the second is between Johnny Lytle Avenue and Fair Street.
Lawrence	Ironton	Ironton Riverfront Trail	\$1,280,750.00	\$500,000.00	This proposal is for the development of 7,125 linear feet of bike lanes, shared used trail and intersection improvements. This project will connect the new Ironton Transit Center in downtown Ironton with the North Ironton neighborhood and the proposed Ironton Marina and Recreational Facility.
Ashtabula	Ashtabula Township Park Commission	Indian Trail Park	\$691,223.00	\$500,000.00	Construction of 150 linear feet of 14 foot wide pedestrian timber truss covered bridge and 50 linear feet of approaches, which will span the Ashtabula River. The bridge will link to a 3,000 feet developed trail surface and an existing paved parking lot and restroom.
Darke	Darke County Park District	Tecumseh Trail Phase 3	\$333,350.00	\$250,000.00	Acquisition of two land parcels and the construction of 1.5 miles by a 10 foot wide asphalt trail. This project is the next phase of construction in the trail development plan for Darke County Park District, which will eventually link Darke County to the Great Miami River Recreational Trail system in Miami County and the I-75 trail corridor (through Bradford, OH) to the east and to the Cardinal Greenway in Indiana (through Union City, OH/IN) in the west.
Montgomery	Centerville-Washington Park District	Holes Creek Multi-Use Trail	\$760,711.00	\$500,000.00	Design and construction of 5,647 linear feet of a 10 feet wide multi-use asphalt trail along Upper Holes Creek. The project will also include two bridges and three culvert crossings over side streams of Holes Creek.
Delaware	Orange Township Parks	Powell Road Trail - Phase I	\$381,825.00	\$248,186.00	Powell Road, Phase I will begin at the South Old State/Powell Road intersection, and will be constructed on the north side of Powell Road within the road right-of-way, running west 1957 linear feet creating the west terminus.
Sandusky	Bellevue	North Coast Inland Trail	\$1,293,364.00	\$176,368.00	Design and construction of 2.87 miles of a 10 foot wide multi-purpose blacktop surface trail. The project will be an extension of the recently completed Clyde to Bellevue segment of the North Coast Inland Trail.

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Pickaway	Pickaway County Park District	Roundtown Trail	\$209,525.00	\$150,000.00	Development of 5,500 linear feet multi-use recreational trail. This trail will be a 10 foot wide asphalt paved surface that will connect with other on and off-road trails. Additional connected trails are planned in future phases.
Auglaize	New Bremen	AUG-M&E Canal Shared Use Trail	\$819,182.00	\$249,815.00	Engineer and construction 1.12 miles by a 10 foot wide paved shared pedestrian, handicapped and bicycle path from the Lock Tender's House in downtown New Bremen north to Lock Two Road, connecting the downtown with the Kuenning-Dicke Natural Area and Bremenfest Park.
Marion	Marion County Park District	Marion Tallgrass Trail - Phase II	\$667,000.00	\$500,000.00	This project will extend the Marion Tall Grass Trail by 15,500 linear feet (2.94 miles) by 10 foot wide, approximately 1/4 of a mile from the existing phase one trailhead parking lot and trail center building.
Cuyahoga	Cleveland Heights	Cedar Glen Multipurpose Trail	\$389,960.00	\$92,896.00	Design and construction of 1,650 linear feet of a 10 feet wide multi-use trail between Cleveland Heights and Case Western University Circle.
Summit	Hudson Parks	Veterans Trail	\$910,981.00	\$301,139.00	Construction of a multi purpose asphalt trail that will be 8,305 linear feet by 10 feet wide. The proposed project is the second phase of the mutli-phase project. This proposed project will continue construction down Prospect Street along Morse Road.
Allen	Spencerville	Spencerville Canal Trail	\$94,157.00	\$38,496.00	This project is proposing the construction of a compact stone base multi-use recreational trail that is 1-mile long and 10 feet wide. The development of two trailhead facilities are also a part of this grant proposal.
Columbiana	East Palestine	Community Biking/Walking Trail	\$160,078.70	\$43,515.00	Construction of 2,350 linear feet of multi-use trail, which will be broken into two segments. Segment I consists of 500 linear feet and Segment II consists 1850 linear feet of trail. These two segments will connect two existing sections of existing community biking/walking trails in the city of East Palestine.
